

EGG HARBOR TOWNSHIP RECREATION COMMISSION

MARCH 16, 2011 MINUTES

1. Minutes:

February 16, 2011 minutes were approved 8-0, with the following corrections.

Public:

Girls Travel Basketball:

Second paragraph, remove the last four lines, beginning with “Furthermore” and ending with “program.”.

Insert the following:

Independent groups had Boy’s and Girl’s Basketball. When Boy’s Basketball folded, Recreation picked up the intramural league and PAL picked up the Travel League. When Girl’s Basketball folded, PAL picked it up. When it folded under PAL, Recreation picked up the intramural girl’s program, just as they did for the boys.

EHTYO – Football:

Fourth line remove “filed” and insert followed.

2. Public:

Bill Mascuilli stated that EHTYO wishes to replace a scoreboard at Veteran’s Park. An area business has shown an interest is providing a new scoreboard. Questions were asked regarding the size of the scoreboard. Mascuilli was advised to contact EHT’s Construction/Inspection Official to ascertain whether permits were necessary and the proper steps to take. Preliminary approval was granted contingent on the meeting with the EHT Construction/Inspection Official.

Bill indicated that EHTYO also had a “wish list” of things that they would like done at the park, which was provided to the Recreation Commission. He was advised to meet with Public Works to discuss the list.

3. Old Business:

Pilipino Festival: Have not received a response from the group.

Travel Basketball: Letter was sent to William Pappas advising that the Commission voted to continue supporting the Egg Harbor Township Recreation Girl’s Basketball program at the Community Center.

4. Use of Facilities:

A. Men’s Senior League (over 30 EHT Orioles) requested use of Bargaintown Park , on Sunday from 9 am to 1 pm, May 11 through September 11, 2011. Approved 8-0 pending the receipt of the team’s roster.

B. Men’s senior League (over 30 EHT Orioles) requested use of Bargaintown Park, on Saturday May 7 and June 11, 2011, from 6 – 10 pm. Approved 8-0 pending receipt of the team’s roster.

C. Atlantic Cape Community College requested use of Bargaintown Park for intercollegiate baseball. A team roster is required. 80 % of the participants must meet the residency rule. Approval for use contingent upon the 80% residency rule was 5 yes, 1 no and 2 abstentions.
