

**EGG HARBOR TOWNSHIP RECREATION COMMISSION
APRIL 21, 2010 MINUTES**

Attendees: Fairfield, Fiedor, Davis, Gallagher, Hiller, Lincoln, Rispoli and Warrell.

1. Minutes:

March 31, 2010 minutes were approved 7-0.

2. Use of Facilities:

EHT Police League – Orioles: Approval to use Bargaintown Park on Sundays, from May 16 - September 13, was approved by a vote of 7-0. Roster and insurance information have been received. The residency requirement of 80% has been met.

Praise Tabernacle: Request to use Canale Park and the amphitheatre, on Sunday, July 25 was approved by a vote of 7-0.

United Filipino Community Movement: Request to use Canale Park and amphitheatre, on August 7, was approved by a vote of 7-0.

EHT Baseball: Request to use the baseball field at Canale Park, was tabled until the next meeting.

FAA: Request to use the softball field at Shires was denied by a vote of 7-0.

3. New Business:

Financial Disclosure: The form was sent to a few Recreation Commissioners. It must be completed and submitted to the Township Clerk's office.

4. Public:

Soccer: Tom McLaughlin and Ted Rush addressed the Commission. Soccer has a "no cut" policy. All intramural teams are comprised entirely of EHT residents. However, the travel teams may have non-residents on the team. This is due to not enough EHT residents wanting to commit to a travel team. Bob Fairfield requested information on the number of non-residents participating in the EHT program. Tom indicated that Soccer is still in the process of taking registration for the 2010 season. Upon completion of Soccer registration, Tom will submit the number of non-residents wishing to participate on an EHT travel Soccer team. Once the numbers are submitted to the Recreation Commission a decision will be made on non-resident participation. Soccer was informed that all of the other EHT 18U Recreation programs are comprised of 100% EHT residents, as is the Recreation requirement.

Basketball: Bill Pappas addressed the Commission. He asked whether Recreation will run a Girls' Travel Basketball program. Bob Lincoln stated that he will run a Recreational program only. He won't let the program die.

5. Old Business:

Recreation By-Laws: Wanda is preparing by-laws for the Recreation Commission.
