## MAY 18, 2011 MINUTES

1. **Minutes:** April 20, 2011 minutes were approved by a vote of 8-0.

2. **Public:**

- Presentation of awards for the Snowman Contest.

- EHTYO President:

Brian Devers introduced himself as the new EHTYO President. He informed the Commission of a proposed change to the CMCJFL by-laws. Wherein, coaches who switch leagues must sit out one year prior to resuming coaching duties. This ruling also affects the players. It states that they cannot move to another league once they have been established with a league, such as EHTYO or EHT PAL. Brian will write a letter to CMCJFL protesting this decision as it is unfair to the players. The children of EHT are the ones hurt by this decision.

3. **Old Business:**

Elections were held. Bob Fairfield, Kathy Fiedor and Toni-Lynn Rispoli were approved unanimously to retain their positions.

4. **Use of Facilities:**

**EHT Baseball Club** requested use of Bargaintown Park on Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday of each week commencing on June 6 through July 27, from 3:30-10:00 pm. A temporary approval was granted contingent upon reducing the number of nights per week from three to two. Vote 8-0.

**Kiddie Korner** requested use of Canale park Ampitheater for their pre-school graduation. Approved by a vote of 7 with 1 abstention.

**EHTLA** requested use of the LAX/Football field for a Girls Lacrosse Clinic the week of July 4 through July 8. Approval granted by a vote of 8-0.

5. **New Business:**

**Home Run Derby** will be held at Childs Kirk Park on June 3, 2011. Registration at 5:00pm and commencement of Derby at 6:00pm, on field 7.

**Recreation Department** was advised that there is \$150,000.00 available for capital improvements. Items that need immediate attention were: Dugouts at Childs Kirk Park need to be raised on fields 3, 5, 6 & 7. They flood which causes a health hazard; lights on football field 5 at Vet's Park; convert Baseball field 6 to a 50/70 field; and, resurface Street Hockey Courts.
