**1. Minutes:**

May 19, 2010 minutes were approved by a 7-0 vote.

**2. Public:**

Girls Basketball: Bill Pappas addressed the Commission. He inquired about the possibility of having Recreation sponsored Girl's Travel Basketball team. He volunteered to start the program and coach. He indicated that he contacted Scott McCarthy concerning use of a school facility and discovered that he would be charged. Bob Lincoln advised that Recreation will have Boys and Girls Basketball teams. However, they will not travel.

Traveling Competitive Cheerleading: Sharon Mitchell addressed the Commission. She advised that the team won several awards and proudly displayed them. Registration will be held in September. A use of facility for Slaybaugh School was requested for Monday and Wednesday, 6-9 pm. They are considered a category 3 group.

**3. Use of Facility:**

EHT Baseball Club: Lynette Buckley addressed the Commission. She stated that the EHT Baseball Club is comprised of only EHT residents. The club is open to all EHT residents regardless of their school affiliation. They are not in the same league as last year. The names and addresses of all the participants will be provided, in writing, to Bob Lincoln. The club is willing to maintain the facility, but must go through Bill Shaw/Public Works. Approved by a vote of 7-0. Must follow the scheduled received for June, July and August.

Grace Family Church: Request to use The amphitheatre on August 27, from 1-8pm was approved by a vote of 7-0.

Dog Park: Donna Burns contacted the County with regard to available space for a dog park. Dennis Levinson indicated that the county is willing to donate 5 acres of property on Pine Avenue for the dog park. It is his understanding that no public funds, municipal or county, will be used for this project.
