

EGG HARBOR TOWNSHIP RECREATION COMMISSION

September 15, 2010 Minutes

Attendees: Fairfield, Davis, Gallagher, Hiller, Lincoln, Messina, Rispoli, and Warrell.

1. Minutes: August 18, 2010 minutes were approved 7-0.

2. Old Business:

School Board fees- The fee structure for use of the school facilities was reviewed. Recreation is included in Category III and will be charged.

3. Use of Facility:

EHT Baseball Club- Request to use Bargaintown Park was denied 7-0. The decision was based on the club consisting of EHT High School players. The club was referred to the school system to request use of their Baseball fields. The football field, at Vet's Park, encompasses the #3 baseball field. Therefore the request to use field #3 is moot.

Barracudas AAU team request to use Vet's Park's field #4 was sent to the EHTBO to discuss with the Baseball sub-committee. Vote 7-0.

Girls' Travel Basketball- Bill Pappas inquired about gym time at the Community Center for his travel basketball team. He was informed that availability is not known. Sign-ups for the Boys' and Girls' Recreation Basketball programs will not conclude until the beginning of November. In past years Miller School was used free of charge, along with the Community Center. However, the EHT School Board will charge EHT Recreation \$450.00, per week, to use the Miller School gym. Therefore, no definitive answer was given. It was suggested that he contact the EHT School Board.

4. New Business:

2011 Recreation Budget:

Peter Miller informed Recreation that salaries of the Director, Assistant Director and clerk must come from the dedicated trust fund.

Community Center Fee structure:

Numerous groups have requested "Use of Facility" for the Multi-purpose room, gym and meeting rooms. Since they are not on the approved list, Township Committee

must decide whether to include them. A letter will be forwarded to Township Committee requesting an ordinance to include these groups and an applicable fee structure.

Amphitheatre:

A few area residents complained about the noise level from the amphitheatre at Tony Canale Park. In the future, groups will be limited on the decibel level and the time of day that sound systems can be used.

Home Run Derby:

EHT resident Victoria Szrom won the Local and Regional 10U Home Run Derby. Her next step is Citizen's Bank Park in Philadelphia. An invitation to recognize her achievement will be sent.
