MINUTES

Deputy Mayor Hodson called the Meeting to Order, 5:02 PM.

Deputy Township Clerk Hughes read the Opening Statement Pursuant to the Open Public Meetings Act.

Deputy Mayor Hodson advised that Mayor McCullough is en route and should arrive within 20 minutes. Also in attendance was Township Administrator Miller, Solicitor Friedman, Engineer Mott and Deputy Clerk Hughes.

Meeting with Township Engineer Mott

Engineer Mott advised that due to the weather, he did not have much to report on. There was a brief discussion on the West Atlantic City Bulkhead grant. Engineer Mott advised that if Pleasantville does not participate, our chances of getting the grant are slim to none.

New Business

Bargaintown Volunteer Fire Co. Fire Truck

In attendance were Bargaintown Fire Chief Gene Sharpe and Egg Harbor Township Fire Chief Rob Winkler. Chief Sharpe advised the governing body of their need for a new fire truck. He explained they are currently using a truck from the 80's and another from the early 90's. One of the two trucks has more issues than the other, but both are failing and costing the township a significant amount of money in repairs. He would like to sell both of them and get one new truck. The township budgeted \$400,000 in 2015 for the purchase of a new truck for Bargaintown, but after much research the truck they would like to purchase is approximately \$65,000 over the budgeted amount. They'd like to purchase the truck through Rosenbauer for several reasons, specifically they will allow the fire company to use equipment off of the old trucks on the new truck, i.e. ladders, which would save approximately \$20,000.

Administrator Miller explained three (3) options the fire company has; find a truck for the budgeted amount, have the governing body amend our capital ordinance to appropriate the additional funds needed, keeping in mind that funds would not be available until sometime in April due to ordinance needing a public hearing or use the \$75,000 balance in the fire

department's vehicles and equipment account from 2014. Most of the money in that account was earmarked for generators for the five (5) stations. The former chief decided not to purchase the generators. Administrator Miller explained that this option would allow Bargaintown to purchase the vehicle by March 1st and delivery would be around January 2017. He further explained that as part of the 2016 budget process the committee could authorize the \$75,000 be put back in capital if Fire Chief Winkler had a plan for the funds. Discussion followed regarding the 2014 balance of funds and the \$75,000 being used for radios.

Chief Winkler expressed his concerns on using the \$75,000 that was appropriated for the fire department and not one company and now we are spending it all on one company.

Administrator Miller said technically the fire department decided not to purchase five (5) generators for \$15,000 per company, therefore the money goes back to the township and the township can re-appropriate it for the purchase of a fire truck.

Administrator Miller reiterated that the municipality has a commitment to convert all radios to be in compliance with the P25 system and Chief Winkler will need to provide him with a list of additional radios needed and why. Administrator Miller said there is no action required on the governing body's part, but Chief Winkler needs to agree he will execute the purchase order for the two (2) accounts.

Fire Chief Winkler asked if the proceeds of the sale of fire trucks will go back to the fire department. Administrator Miller replied, no. Committeeman Pfrommer questioned if the proceeds were going to be used for the enhancement of the truck. Chief Sharpe answered yes. Administrator Miller believes the truck could be donated to them, but he requested Solicitor Friedman look into it.

Bus Shelters

Administrator Miller advised NJ Transit has funding available to install several new bus shelters in Egg Harbor Township and provided a list of their proposed locations. Resolution No. 122 listed for tonight approves NJ Transit's proposed list.

Emergency Management Assistance Grant

Administrator Miller referred to Resolution No. 117 which accepts Emergency Management Agency Assistance Grant and authorizes acceptance of federal funds. In attendance was Chief Davis/Emergency Management Coordinator who explained that the grant will be used for reimbursement of his salary and wages.

Atlantic County Multi-Jurisdictional Natural Hazard Mitigation Plan

Administrator Miller said Atlantic County has adopted a Multi-Jurisdictional Natural Hazard Mitigation Plan which basically says that we will all work together on any hazards. Resolution 120 listed for consideration tonight accepts the county plan as our plan.

Post Sandy Planning Assistance Grant

Resolution No. 118 schedule for consideration authorizes the administration to submit applications for Post Sandy Planning Assistance Grants. Administrator Miller said that the first grant available is for \$30,000 and will be used for planning. After the township applies for the first grant we will be eligible to apply for others.

Mayor McCullough arrived to the meeting, 5:45 PM.

National Joint Purchasing Alliance

Administrator Miller referred to Resolution No. 121 authorizing participation in the national cooperative contract with National Joint Purchasing Alliance vendors and explained that through these co-ops we do not have to formally bid which will improve our options for purchasing.

ABC “D” License

Ordinance No. 5 scheduled for public hearing this evening increases the number of Plenary Retail Distribution License from four (4) to five (5). Resolution No. 133 allows for a public sale of the new license, scheduled for Wednesday, May 25th.

Other Business

Administrator Miller said he has one add-on resolution for consideration later in the meeting, Resolution 135 amending the temporary budget.

Deputy Township Clerk Hughes read the Video Broadcast/Television Statement.

2016

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 173 OF THE TOWNSHIP CODE ENTITLED "PROPERTY MAINTENANCE" REQUIRING REGISTRATION AND MAINTENANCE OF CERTAIN REAL PROPERTY MORTGAGES; AND THE REGULATION, LIMITATION AND REDUCTION OF ABANDONED REAL PROPERTY

WHEREAS, the present mortgage foreclosure crisis has serious negative implications for all communities trying to manage the consequences of property vacancies and abandoned real properties; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Egg Harbor recognizes an increase in the number of vacancies and abandoned properties located throughout the Township; and

WHEREAS, the Township is challenged to identify and locate owners or foreclosing parties who can maintain the properties that are in the foreclosure process or that have been foreclosed; and

WHEREAS, the Township finds that the presence of vacant and abandoned properties can lead to a decline in property value, create attractive nuisances and lead to a general decrease in neighborhood and community aesthetics; and

WHEREAS, the Township has already adopted property maintenance codes to regulate building standards for the exterior of structures and the condition of the property as a whole; and

WHEREAS, the Township desires to amend the Township Code in order to participate in the County-wide registration program established by the Atlantic County Improvement Authority; and

WHEREAS, the Township has a vested interest in protecting neighborhoods against decay caused by vacant and abandoned properties and concludes that it is in the best interests of the health, safety, and welfare of its citizens and residents to impose registration and certification requirements on abandoned and vacant properties located within the Township;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Egg Harbor, County of Atlantic and State of New Jersey that:

SECTION 1. The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this Article upon the adoption hereof:

SECTION 2. Chapter 173 is hereby amended by adding the following new article:

ARTICLE VIII ABANDONED REAL PROPERTY

§173-31. Purpose and Intent

It is the purpose and intent of the Township to establish a process to address the deterioration and blight of Township neighborhoods caused by an increasing amount of abandoned, foreclosed or distressed real property located within the Township, and to identify, regulate, limit and reduce the number of abandoned properties. It is the Township's further intent to participate in the County-wide registration program established by the Atlantic County Improvement Authority as a mechanism to protect neighborhoods from becoming blighted due to the lack of adequate maintenance and security of abandoned and foreclosed properties.

§173-32. Definitions

The following words, terms and phrases, when used in this Article, shall have the meanings ascribed to them in this section, except where the context clearly indicates a different meaning.

Abandoned Real Property - means any real property located in the Township, whether vacant or occupied, that is in default on a mortgage, has had a lis pendens filed against it by the Lender holding a mortgage on the property, is subject to an ongoing foreclosure action by the Lender, is subject to an application for a tax deed or pending tax assessors lien sale, or has been transferred to the Lender under a deed in lieu of foreclosure. The designation of a property as "abandoned" shall remain in place until such time as the property is sold or transferred to a new owner, the foreclosure action has been dismissed, and any default on the mortgage has been cured.

Accessible Property/Structure - means a property that is accessible through a comprised/breached gate, fence, wall, etc. or a structure that is unsecured and/or breached in such a way as to allow access to the interior space by unauthorized persons.

Applicable Codes - means to include, but not be limited to, the Code of the Township of Egg Harbor and the New Jersey Uniform Construction Code.

Blighted Property - means:

- a) Properties that have broken or severely damaged windows, doors, walls, or roofs which create hazardous conditions and encourage trespassing; or
- b) Properties whose maintenance is not in conformance with the maintenance of other neighboring properties causing a decrease in value of the neighboring properties; or

c) Properties cited for a public nuisance pursuant to the Township Property Maintenance Code and/or New Jersey Uniform Construction Code; or

d) Properties that endanger the public's health, safety, or welfare because the properties or improvements thereon are dilapidated, deteriorated, or violate minimum health and safety standards or lacks maintenance as required by the Code of the Township of Egg Harbor and/or New Jersey Uniform Construction Code.

Enforcement Officer - means any law enforcement officer, building official, zoning inspector, zoning officer, code enforcement officer, fire inspector or building inspector, or other person authorized by the Township to enforce the applicable code(s).

Owner - means any person, legal entity or other party having any ownership interest whether legal or equitable, in real property. This term shall also apply to any person, legal entity or agent responsible for the construction, maintenance or operation of the property involved.

Property Management Company - means a local property manager, property Maintenance Company or similar entity responsible for the maintenance of abandoned real property.

Vacant - means any building or structure that is not legally occupied.

§173-33. Applicability

These sections shall be considered cumulative and not superseding or subject to any other law or provision for same, but rather be an additional remedy available to the Township above and beyond any other state, county or local provisions for same.

§173-34. Establishment of a Registry

Pursuant to the provisions of §172-35, the Township or designee shall participate in the County-wide registration program established by the Atlantic County Improvement Authority cataloging each Abandoned Property within the Township, containing the information required by this Article.

§173-35. Registration of Abandoned Real Property

(a) Any mortgagee who holds a mortgage on real property located within the Township shall perform an inspection of the property to determine vacancy or occupancy, upon default by the mortgagor. The mortgagee shall, within ten (10) days of the inspection, register the property with the Division of Inspections, or designee, on forms or website access provided by the Township, and indicate

whether the property is vacant or occupied. A separate registration is required for each property, whether it is found to be vacant or occupied.

(b) If the property is occupied but remains in default, it shall be inspected by the mortgagee or his designee monthly until (1) the mortgagor or other party remedies the default; or (2) it is found to be vacant or shows evidence of vacancy at which time it is deemed abandoned, and the mortgagee shall, within ten (10) days of that inspection, update the property registration to a vacancy status on forms provided by the Township.

(c) Registration pursuant to this section shall contain the name of the mortgagee and the server, the direct mailing address of the mortgagee and the server, a direct contact name and telephone number for both parties, facsimile number and e-mail address for both parties, the folio or tax number, and the name and twenty-four (24) hour contact telephone number of the property management company responsible for the security and maintenance of the property.

(d) A non-refundable annual registration fee in the amount of five hundred dollars (\$500.00) per property, shall accompany the registration form or website registration.

(e) All registration fees must be paid directly from the Mortgagee, Servicer, Trustee, or Owner. Third Party Registration fees are not allowed without the consent of the Township and/or its authorized designee.

(f) This section shall also apply to properties that have been the subject of a foreclosure sale where the title was transferred to the beneficiary of a mortgage involved in the foreclosure and any properties transferred under a deed in lieu of foreclosure/sale.

(g) Properties subject to this section shall remain under the annual registration requirement, and the inspection, security and maintenance standards of this section as long as they remain vacant or in default.

(h) Any person or legal entity that has registered a property under this section must report any change of information contained in the registration within ten (10) days of the change.

(i) Failure of the mortgagee and/or owner to properly register or to modify the registration form from time to time to reflect a change of circumstances as required by this article is a violation of the article and shall be subject to enforcement.

(j) Pursuant to any administrative or judicial finding and determination that any property is in violation of this article, the Township may take the necessary action to ensure compliance with and place a lien on the property for the cost of the work performed to benefit the property and bring it into compliance.

§173-36. Maintenance Requirements

(a) Properties subject to this chapter shall be kept free of weeds, overgrown brush, dead vegetation, trash, junk, debris, building materials, any accumulation of newspapers, circulars, flyers, notices, except those required by federal, state or local law discarded personal items including, but not limited to, furniture, clothing, large and small appliances, printed material or any other items that give the appearance that the property is abandoned.

(b) The property shall be maintained free of graffiti or similar markings by removal or painting over with an exterior grade paint that matches the color of the exterior structure.

(c) Front, side, and rear yards, including landscaping, shall be maintained in accordance with the applicable code(s) at the time registration was required.

(d) Yard maintenance shall include, but not be limited to, grass, ground covers, bushes, shrubs, hedges or similar plantings, decorative rock or bark or artificial turf/sod designed specifically for residential installation. Acceptable maintenance of yards and/or landscape shall not include weeds, gravel, broken concrete, asphalt or similar material.

(e) Maintenance shall include, but not be limited to, watering, irrigation, cutting and mowing of required ground cover or landscape and removal of all trimmings.

(f) Pools and spas shall be maintained so the water remains free and clear of pollutants and debris and shall comply with the regulations set forth in the applicable code(s).

(g) Failure of the mortgagee and/or owner to properly maintain the property may result in a violation of the applicable code(s) and issuance of a citation or Notice of Violation in accordance with §173-39. Pursuant to a finding and determination by the Township's Code Enforcement Officer or a court of competent jurisdiction, the Township may take the necessary action to ensure compliance with this section.

(h) In addition to the above, the property is required to be maintained in accordance with the applicable code(s).

§173-37. Security Requirements

(a) Properties subject to this Chapter shall be maintained in a secure manner so as not to be accessible to unauthorized persons.

(b) A "secure manner" shall include, but not be limited to, the closure and locking of windows, doors, gates and other openings of such size that may allow a child to access the interior of the property or structure. Broken windows, doors, gates and other openings of such size that may allow a child to access the interior of the property or structure must be repaired. Broken windows shall be secured by reglazing of the window.

(c) If a mortgage on a property is in default, and the property has become vacant or abandoned, a property manager shall be designated by the mortgagee to perform the work necessary to bring the property into compliance with the applicable code(s), and the property manager must perform regular inspections to verify compliance with the requirements of this article, and any other applicable laws.

§173-38. Public Nuisance

All abandoned real property is hereby declared to be a public nuisance, the abatement of which pursuant to the police power is hereby declared to be necessary for the health, welfare and safety of the residents of the Township.

§173-39. Violations and Penalties

A mortgagee and/or owner subject to this article found by the Municipal Court, or by any other court of competent jurisdiction, to be in violation of the requirement to care, maintain, secure or upkeep a property as cited in the notice issued pursuant to the article shall be subject to a fine of fifteen hundred dollars (\$1,500) for each day of the violation. Any fines imposed pursuant to this section shall commence thirty one thirty one (31) days following receipt of the notice, except if the violation presents an imminent risk to public health and safety, in which case any fines shall commence eleven (11) days following receipt of this notice.

§173-40. Inspections for Violations

Adherence to this article does not relieve any person, legal entity or agent from any other obligations set forth in any applicable code(s), which may apply to the property. Upon sale or transfer of title to the property, the owner shall be responsible for all violations of the applicable code(s) and the owner shall be responsible for meeting with the Township's Code Enforcement Officer within forty-five (45) days for a final courtesy inspection report.

§173-41. Additional Authority

a) If the enforcement officer has reason to believe that a property subject to the provisions of this article is posing a serious threat to the public health safety and welfare, the code enforcement officer

may temporarily secure the property at the expense of the mortgagee and/or owner, and may bring the violations before the Municipal Court as soon as possible to address the conditions of the property.

(b) The Municipal Judge shall have the authority to require the mortgagee and/or owner of record of any property affected by this section, to implement additional maintenance and/or security measure including, but not limited to, securing any and all doors, windows or other openings, employment of an on-site security guard or other measures as may be reasonably required to help prevent further decline of the property.

(c) If there is a finding that the condition of the property is posing a serious threat to the public health, safety and welfare, then the Municipal Court may direct the Township to abate the violations and charge the mortgagee with the cost of the abatement.

(d) If the mortgagee does not reimburse the Township for the cost of temporarily securing the property, or of any abatement directed by the Municipal Court, within thirty (30) days of the Township sending the mortgagee the invoice then the Township may lien the property with such cost, along with an administrative fee of five hundred (\$500.00) to recover the administrative personnel services.

§173-42. Opposing, Obstructing Enforcement Officer; Penalty

Whoever opposes, obstructs or resists any enforcement officer or any person authorized by the enforcement office in the discharge of duties as provided in this Article shall be punishable as provided in the applicable code(s) or a court of competent jurisdiction.

§173-43. Immunity of Enforcement Officer

Any enforcement officer or any person authorized by the Township to enforce the sections here within shall be immune from prosecution, civil or criminal, for reasonable, good faith entry upon real property while in the discharge of duties imposed by this article.

SECTION 3: All ordinances or parts of ordinances which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are, to the extent of such inconsistency, hereby repealed.

SECTION 4: Should any section, clause, sentence, phrase or provision of this Ordinance be declared unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance.
