MINUTES

Mayor McCullough called the meeting to order, 5:00 PM.

Deputy Township Clerk Hughes read the Opening Statement Pursuant to the Open Public Meetings Act.

Also in attendance was Solicitor Friedman, Engineer Mott, Administrator Miller and Deputy Township Clerk Hughes.

Meeting with Township Engineer Mott

Community Center Generator

Engineer Mott reported the generator was delivered to the community center earlier this week. He said installation will commence within in the next ten (10) days and take approximately two weeks to complete. Mayor McCullough questioned what the generator will operate. Engineer Mott said it will operate the lights, and the heating and air conditioning, intermittently. A general discussion followed regarding the current issues with the heating and air conditioning at the center and it was decided that Administrator Miller will reach out to Concord Atlantic Engineers.

South Jersey Transportation Organization

Engineer Mott reported the South Jersey Transportation Planning Organization recently came out with grants that were due within the past couple of weeks. These grants are to provide funding to municipalities for traffic control at municipal intersections. Engineer Mott advised that he received the organizations ranking of those intersections in need and we were ranked in the top five for the intersection of West Jersey and Ridge Avenues and the intersection of West Jersey and Fernwood Avenues. The grant would provide us with approximately \$2 million.

Also, there were grants available for safety programs, specifically rumble strips. He proposed rumble strips on West Jersey Avenue, Ridge Avenue and Tremont Avenue. Engineer Mott explained that the rumble strips would be in the center of the roadway and when approaching the stop sign. The strips would not be humps, but instead comparable to when approaching the toll plaza on the expressway.

New Business

Price's Pit In-Rem Foreclosure Settlement

Administrator Miller referred to prior authorization he and Solicitor Friedman were given by governing body to settle the case. A settlement was reached and Resolution 160 authorizes the Mayor and

Township Clerk to execute Settlement Agreement with Dewey Place, LLC. Administrator Miller gave a brief explanation of the terms within the agreement.

Canale Park Bathroom

Administrator Miller reported two (2) bids were received on February 24th for the Prefabricated and Preassembled Restroom Unit. The lowest and responsible bidder recommended by Recreation Director Audet is Oldcastle Precast, Inc. of Easton, Pennsylvania with an award amount of \$136,731. Resolution 157 is listed for consideration this evening awarding the contract to them. Discussion followed on timeframe of installation and the line that has to be run from Dogwood Avenue. Administrator Miller said the project is expected to be complete in October of this year and soccer is content.

County Foreclosure Shared Services Agreement

Administrator Miller referred to Resolution No. 158 for consideration later this evening. This resolution authorizes a Shared Services Agreement between the County and participating municipalities in the County-Wide Registration Program. Administrator Miller explained that this agreement requires foreclosed properties to be registered with the municipality through a County-wide registration program administered by Community Champions Corporation and is a component of Ordinance No. 4 of 2016 adopted at their February 17th meeting.

Econsult Agreement

The Administrator referred to our agreement through Rutgers University with Dr. Burchell as an expert in COAH litigation. Unfortunately, Dr. Burchell became ill and was unable to complete his obligations in the Research Agreement. As a result, Rutgers University retained an alternate expert and modified the agreement. Resolution No. 159 scheduled for adoption this evening authorizes our participation and execution of agreement with Econsult Solutions, Inc.

Other Business

Supplemental Agenda

Administrator Miller advised committee members that there will be a supplemental agenda for consideration this evening. The agenda includes resolution's 174 through 177. Administrator Miller explained that Resolution No. 174 is necessary to facilitate the sale of 303 Carver Avenue. The owner passed away and the property is in dire need of rehabilitation. The contract sale price is less than the amount owed on a loan with the Atlantic County Improvement Authority. Administrator Miller said it is in the Township's best interest to accept a reduced amount instead of the property being foreclosed on. Resolution No. 175 grants Family Medical Leave Act leave without pay to an employee in the police department. Resolution No. 176 appoints an existing part-time dispatcher to full-time and Resolution 177 approves Mark Warnock in the Tax Collector's office from probationary to permanent status.

Administrator Miller also advised the committee that Resolution No. 169 appointing Dena Danz as Program Manager in the Department of Parks and Recreation has been revised since Friday's agenda distribution. A typographical error was made in her bi-weekly salary.

Ordinance No. 8 2016

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 6 OF THE TOWNSHIP CODE ENTITLED "ADMINISTRATION OF GOVERNMENT"

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Committee for the Township of Egg Harbor, County of Atlantic and State of New Jersey that:

SECTION 1: Chapter 6 of the Code of the Township of Egg Harbor, specifically Section 6-84 is hereby amended by deleting existing subsection C in its entirety and replacing it as follows:

§6-84 Education requirements for Police Department

- C. The following educational standards are established within the ranks of the Police Department:

Rank	Minimum Degree/Education
Chief	Masters in Criminal Justice or related field
Captain	Masters in Criminal Justice or related field
Lieutenant	Baccalaureate in Criminal Justice or related field
Sergeant	Baccalaureate in Criminal Justice or related field or four years of active United States Military Service with an honorable discharge in its place
Police Officer	Baccalaureate degree or four years of active United States Military Service with an honorable discharge in its place

SECTION 2: All ordinances or parts of ordinances which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are, to the extent of such inconsistency, hereby repealed.

SECTION 3: Should any section, clause, sentence, phrase or provision of this Ordinance be declared unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance shall take effect upon final passage, adoption and publication in the manner prescribed by law.
