Ordinance No. 12

2017

An ordinance granting consent and permission to Cellco Partnership (D/B/A Verizon Wireless) to locate and operate small network nodes in the public right-of-way in the Township of Egg Harbor by attaching to existing utility poles pursuant to N.J.S.A. 48:3-18 and N.J.S.A 48:3-19

WHEREAS, Cellco Partnership d/b/a Verizon Wireless, (“Verizon Wireless”), is a provider of commercial mobile service subject to regulation by the Federal Communications Commission; and

WHEREAS, Verizon Wireless has entered into agreements with parties that have the lawful right to maintain poles in the public right-of-way pursuant to which Verizon Wireless may use such existing poles erected within the public right-of-way in the Township of Egg Harbor; and

WHEREAS, New Jersey law permits such use provided that there is the consent of the relevant municipality;

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Committee of Egg Harbor, County of Atlantic and State of New Jersey that:

SECTION 1. Permission and authority are hereby granted to Verizon Wireless and its successors and assigns, to use existing poles erected by parties that have the lawful right to maintain poles within the public right-of-way in the Township of Egg Harbor, subject to the following:

- A. Verizon Wireless, and its successors and assigns, shall adhere to all applicable Federal, State, and Local laws regarding safety requirements related to the use of the public right-of-way.
- B. Verizon Wireless, and its successors and assigns, shall comply with all applicable Federal, State, and Local laws requiring permits prior to beginning construction, and shall obtain any applicable permits that may be required by the Township of Egg Harbor.
- C. Such permission be and is hereby given upon the condition and provision that Verizon Wireless, and its successors and assigns, shall to the fullest extent permitted by law, defend, pay on behalf of, indemnify, and hold harmless the Township of Egg Harbor, its elected and appointed officials, its agents, employees and volunteers and others working on behalf of the Township of Egg Harbor against any and all claims, demands, suits, or loss, including all costs connected therewith, and for any damages which may be asserted, claimed or recovered against or from the Township of Egg Harbor, its elected and appointed officials, its agents, employees, volunteers or others working on behalf of the Township of Egg Harbor, by reason of personal damage, including loss of use thereof, which arises out of or is

- D. in any way connected or associated with this contract, except to the extent resulting from the acts or omissions of the Township of Egg Harbor.
- E. Verizon Wireless shall, at its own cost and expense, maintain commercial general liability insurance in the amount of \$3,000,000 combined single limit per occurrence and automobile insurance with combined single limits of \$2,000,000 for bodily injury (including death) and property damage each occurrence. Workers compensation insurance in compliance with the statutory requirements of the state(s) in which work is performed. The Township of Egg Harbor shall be included as an "Additional Insured" as their interests may appear under this agreement on all general liability policies. Nothing in this section shall limit Verizon Wireless's liability in any way.
- F. Verizon Wireless shall be responsible for the repair of any damage to paving, existing utility lines, or any surface or subsurface installations, arising from its construction, installation or maintenance of its facilities.
- G. Notwithstanding any provision contained herein, neither the Township of Egg Harbor nor Verizon Wireless shall be liable to the other for consequential, incidental, exemplary, or punitive damages on account of any activity pursuant to this instrument.
- H. The permission and authority hereby granted shall continue for the same period of time as the grant to parties whose existing poles Verizon Wireless is using.
- I. This resolution authorizes Verizon Wireless to use existing poles erected within the public right-of-way of the Township of Egg Harbor by parties that have the lawful right to maintain such poles. The small network nodes attached to the existing poles shall not exceed four (4) feet in height.

SECTION 2. All ordinances and parts of Ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are, to the extent of such inconsistency, hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. Should any section, clause, sentence, phrase or provision of this Ordinance be declared unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this ordinance.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon final adoption and publication according to law.

EGG HARBOR TOWNSHIP ORDINANCE 15 -2017

An ordinance authorizing long term tax exemption agreement between the Township of Egg Harbor and Egg Harbor Family 2 Urban Renewal, LLC (Formerly known as Egg Harbor Senior Urban Renewal, LLC)

Egg Harbor Township Ordinance 15-2017 was introduced and passed upon first reading at a meeting of the governing body of the Township of Egg Harbor, in the County of Atlantic, State of New Jersey, held on April 5, 2017, at the Egg Harbor Township Municipal Building. It will be further considered for final passage, after public hearing thereon, at a meeting of the governing body to be held on April 19, 2017, at 5:30 P.M. at the Egg Harbor Township Municipal Building. During the week prior to and up to and including the date of such meeting, copies of the full ordinance will be available at no cost and during regular business hours, at the Clerk's office located in the Municipal Building, 3515 Bargaintown Road, Egg Harbor Township, New Jersey, for the members of the general public who shall request the same. This ordinance authorizes a PILOT (Payment In Lieu of Taxes) program for Egg Harbor Family 2 Urban Renewal, LLC for their construction of 60 family rental units that are COAH certified and are part of the Township affordable housing program. The PILOT is for property located at Block 1029, Lot 1.01. Egg Harbor Family 2 Urban Renewal, LLC shall pay an annual service charge based on five percent (5%) of the annual gross revenue generated from the project.

Ordinance No. 15

2017

An ordinance authorizing long term tax exemption agreement between the Township of Egg Harbor and Egg Harbor Family 2 Urban Renewal, LLC (Formerly known as Egg Harbor Senior Urban Renewal, LLC)

WHEREAS, in compliance with the New Jersey Supreme Court's March 10, 2015 decision in In re Adoption of N.J.A.C. 5:96 and 5:97 by N.J. Council on Affordable Housing, 221 N.J. 1 (2015) ("Mount Laurel IV"), on or about July 2, 2015, the Township filed an action with the Superior Court of New Jersey ("Court") in Atlantic County, entitled In the Matter of the Application of the Township of Egg Harbor, County of Atlantic, Docket No. ATL-L-1506-15, seeking a Judgment of Compliance and Repose approving its Housing Element and Fair Share Plan ("Affordable Housing Plan"), in addition to related reliefs, including temporary immunity from all Mount Laurel lawsuits; and

WHEREAS, the Court granted the Township's motion for temporary immunity from all Mount Laurel lawsuits, which was subsequently extended via a series of orders, and is still in full force and effect today; and

WHEREAS, Egg Harbor Family 2 Urban Renewal LLC (formerly known as Egg Harbor Senior Urban Renewal LLC) (the "Entity") proposes to construct a 60-unit 100% affordable family rental housing development (the "Project") within the Township of Egg Harbor (the "Municipality"), which will aid the Township in complying with its affordable housing obligation, on a site described as Block 1029, Lot 1.01 as shown on the official assessment map of the Township of Egg Harbor, Atlantic County and commonly known as 2720 Fire Road, Egg Harbor Township, New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Long Term Tax Exemption Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:20-1 et. seq. authorizes a municipality to enter into a Financial Agreement with an urban renewal entity undertaking development and construction of a low or moderate income housing project, granting a long term tax exemption to the project; and

WHEREAS, the Entity is qualified to do business under the provisions of the New Jersey Long Term Tax Exemption Law and has made application to the Township of Egg Harbor for (i) the approval of the Project; (ii) the grant of a long term tax exemption for the Project; and (iii) the execution of a Financial Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Entity has presented to the Township Committee a Financial Agreement, which is attached hereto as Exhibit A, and which has attached as an exhibit a revenue projection for the Project which sets forth the anticipated revenue to be received by the Entity from the operation of the Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Egg Harbor, County of Atlantic, State of New Jersey as follows:

SECTION 1.

1. The Township Committee authorizes the execution of the Agreement substantially in the form attached hereto as Exhibit A and made a part hereof authorizing an in lieu tax payment of five percent (5%) of the gross shelter rent of the Project.

2. The exemption from taxation on improvements to be constructed by the Entity on Block 1029, Lot 1.01 be and is hereby approved for a period of thirty (30) years from the date of substantial completion of the Project, but only so long as the Entity is subject to and in compliance with the terms of the Financial Agreement and the Long Term Tax Exemption Law.
3. The Committee hereby authorizes and directs the Mayor to execute, on behalf of the Township, the Agreement attached hereto as Exhibit A.
4. The Committee understands and agrees that the revenue projections set forth in exhibit to the Financial Agreement are estimates and the actual payments in lieu of taxes to be paid by the Entity to the Township shall be determined pursuant to the Agreement.
5. The Township Committee understands that the Entity will form a limited partnership or a limited liability company in which the Entity will be the general partner or managing member, respectively, and that the Township may enter into the payment in lieu of taxes Agreement with such limited partnership or limited liability company.
6. An executed copy of the Financial Agreement authorized by this Ordinance shall be kept on file in the office of the Township Clerk for purposes of review and record.
7. The Project, when completed, shall conform with all State laws and ordinances of the Township of Egg Harbor relating to its construction and use.
8. The Entity shall pay an annual service charge based on five percent (5%) of the annual gross revenue generated from the Project as set forth in the Financial Agreement. The annual service charge rate shall be fixed for the entire term of the tax exemption, but after the initial fifteen (15) years of the term the minimum annual service charge shall be determined as otherwise set forth in the Financial Agreement. Following submission of an annual auditor's report within ninety (90) days of the end of each fiscal or calendar year, the Township and the Entity shall adjust any over payment or under payment determined for the audited period.
9. The Entity shall submit a total Project cost audit by certified public accountants within ninety (90) days following substantial completion of the project.
10. The Municipal Clerk is hereby authorized to forward a certified true copy of this Ordinance to Egg Harbor Family 2 Urban Renewal LLC (formerly known as Egg Harbor Senior Urban Renewal LLC), 3 East Stow Road, Suite 100, Marlton, New Jersey, 08053. The Municipal Clerk is hereby authorized to forward a certified true copy of this Ordinance, and the Financial Agreement implementing it, to both the Tax Assessor and the Director of the Division of Local Government Services.

SECTION 2: All ordinances and parts of Ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are, to the extent of such inconsistency, hereby repealed.

SECTION 3: Should any section, clause, sentence, phrase or provision of this Ordinance be declared unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this ordinance.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon final adoption and publication according to law.

The PILOT is for property located at Block 1904, Lot 1 and Block 2001, Lots 1-4. Eastern Pacific Development, LLC shall pay an annual service charge based on five percent (5%) of the annual gross revenue generated from the project.

2017

An ordinance authorizing long term tax exemption agreement between the Township of Egg Harbor and Eastern Pacific Development, LLC

WHEREAS, in compliance with the New Jersey Supreme Court's March 10, 2015 decision in In re Adoption of N.J.A.C. 5:96 and 5:97 by N.J. Council on Affordable Housing, 221 N.J. 1 (2015) ("Mount Laurel IV"), on or about July 2, 2015, the Township filed an action with the Superior Court of New Jersey ("Court") in Atlantic County, entitled In the Matter of the Application of the Township of Egg Harbor, County of Atlantic, Docket No. ATL-L-1506-15, seeking a Judgment of Compliance and Repose approving its Housing Element and Fair Share Plan ("Affordable Housing Plan"), in addition to related reliefs, including temporary immunity from all Mount Laurel lawsuits; and

WHEREAS, the Court granted the Township's motion for temporary immunity from all Mount Laurel lawsuits, which was subsequently extended via a series of orders, and is still in full force and effect today; and

WHEREAS, Eastern Pacific Development, LLC (the "Entity") proposes to construct a 77-unit 100% affordable housing development (the "Project") within the Township of Egg Harbor (the "Municipality"), which will aid the Township in complying with its affordable housing obligation, on a site described as Block 1904, Lot 1 and Block 2001, Lots 1-4, as shown on the official assessment map of the Township of Egg Harbor, Atlantic County and commonly known as 6641 Blackhorse Pike, Egg Harbor, New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Long Term Tax Exemption Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:20-1 et.seq. authorizes a municipality to enter into a Financial Agreement with an urban renewal entity undertaking development and construction of a low or moderate income housing project, granting a long term tax exemption to the project; and

WHEREAS, the Entity is qualified to do business under the provisions of the New Jersey Long Term Tax Exemption Law and has made application to the Township of Egg Harbor for (i) the approval of the Project; (ii) the grant of a long term tax exemption for the Project; and (iii) the execution of a Financial Agreement.

WHEREAS, the Entity has presented to the Township Committee a Financial Agreement, which is attached hereto as Exhibit A, and which has attached as an exhibit a revenue projection for the Project which sets forth the anticipated revenue to be received by the Entity from the operation of the Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Egg Harbor, County of Atlantic and State of New Jersey as follows:

1. The Township Committee authorizes the execution of the Agreement substantially in the form attached hereto as Exhibit A and made a part hereof authorizing an in lieu tax payment of five percent (5%) of the gross shelter rent of the Project.
2. The exemption from taxation on improvements to be constructed by the Entity on Block 1904, Lot 1 and Block 2001, Lots 1-4, be and is hereby approved for a period

of thirty (30) years from the date of substantial completion of the Project, but only so long as the Entity is subject to and in compliance with the terms of the Financial Agreement and the Long Term Tax Exemption Law.

3. The Committee hereby authorizes and directs the Mayor to execute, on behalf of the Township, the Agreement attached hereto as Exhibit A.
4. The Committee understands and agrees that the revenue projections set forth in exhibit to the Financial Agreement are estimates and the actual payments in lieu of taxes to be paid by the Entity to the Township shall be determined pursuant to the Agreement.
5. The Township understands that the Entity will form a limited partnership or a limited liability company in which the Entity will be the general partner or managing member, respectively, and that the Township may enter into the payment in lieu of taxes Agreement with such limited partnership or limited liability company.
6. An executed copy of the Financial Agreement authorized by this Ordinance shall be kept on file in the office of the Township Clerk for purposes of review and record.
7. The Project, when completed, shall conform with all State laws and ordinances of the Township of Egg Harbor relating to its construction and use.
8. The Entity shall pay an annual service charge based on five percent (5%) of the annual gross revenue generated from the Project as set forth in the Financial Agreement. The annual service charge rate shall be fixed for the entire term of the tax exemption, but after the initial fifteen (15) years of the term the minimum annual service charge shall be determined as otherwise set forth in the Financial Agreement. Following submission of an annual auditor's report within ninety (90) days of the end of each fiscal or calendar year, the Township and the Entity shall adjust any over payment or under payment determined for the audited period.
9. The Entity shall submit a total Project cost audit by certified public accountants within ninety (90) days following substantial completion of the project.
10. The Municipal Clerk is hereby authorized to forward a certified true copy of this Ordinance to Eastern Pacific Development, LLC, 1181 East Landis Avenue, Vineland, New Jersey 08361. The Municipal Clerk is hereby authorized to forward a certified true copy of this Ordinance, and the Financial Agreement implementing it, to both the Municipal Tax Assessor and the Director of the Division of Local Government Services.

SECTION 2: All ordinances and parts of Ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are, to the extent of such inconsistency, hereby repealed.

SECTION 3: Should any section, clause, sentence, phrase or provision of this Ordinance be declared unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this ordinance.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon final adoption and publication according to law.

Council on Affordable Housing, 221 N.J. 1 (2015) ("Mount Laurel IV"), on or about July 2, 2015, the Township filed an action with the Superior Court of New Jersey ("Court") in Atlantic County, entitled In the Matter of the Application of the Township of Egg Harbor, County of Atlantic, Docket No. ATL-L-1506-15, seeking a Judgment of Compliance and Repose approving its Housing Element and Fair Share Plan ("Affordable Housing Plan"), in addition to related reliefs, including temporary immunity from all Mount Laurel lawsuits; and

WHEREAS, the Court granted the Township's motion for temporary immunity from all Mount Laurel lawsuits, which was subsequently extended via a series of orders, and is still in full force and effect today; and

WHEREAS, Eastern Pacific Development, LLC (the "Eastern Pacific") proposes to construct a 77-unit 100% affordable housing development (the "Project") within the Township of Egg Harbor (the "Township"), which will aid the Township in complying with its affordable housing obligation, on a site described as Block 1904, Lot 1 and Block 2001, Lots 1-4, as shown on the official assessment map of the Township of Egg Harbor, Atlantic County and commonly known as 6641 Blackhorse Pike, Egg Harbor, New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, in order to implement the development, financing, construction, operation and management of the Project, Eastern Pacific and the Township's professionals negotiated, drafted and agreed upon a final version of a Development Agreement, which is attached hereto as Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, in order to qualify the Project for financing, the Township has agreed to grant the Project a long term tax exemption in accordance with the provisions of the Long Term Tax Exemption Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:20-1 et. seq., and will enter into a separate Financial Agreement with Eastern Pacific that will set forth the terms and conditions of that long term tax exemption; and

WHEREAS, to ensure that the Project contemplated by this Development Agreement produces creditworthy affordable units that can be applied to the Township's affordable housing obligations, the affordable units shall be developed in accordance with Council on Affordable Housing ("COAH") prior round regulations and all other applicable law, and said affordable units

shall be deed restricted for such purposes for a period of 30 years; and

WHEREAS, the Township is willing to enter into the Development Agreement, which is attached hereto as Exhibit A.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Egg Harbor, County of Atlantic, State of New Jersey that:

1. The Township Committee finds and determines that the proposed Affordable Housing Project, as contemplated in the Development Agreement attached hereto as Exhibit A, will help the Township meet its affordable housing obligations.
2. The Mayor, and all other officials of the Township of Egg Harbor, are hereby directed and authorized to execute said Development Agreement and take all necessary and appropriate actions, to carry out the subject of this Resolution.
3. Upon execution by the parties, a copy of the subject Development Agreement shall be maintained by the Township Clerk for public inspection.
4. The Township Committee hereby directs its Township officials and professionals to take all necessary actions to carry out and complete the terms of the Development Agreement.
5. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
