The public meeting resumed and all members were present.

Meeting with Township Engineer Mott

2016 Road Improvement Program

Township Engineer Mott reported on the status of the 2016 Road Program, see attached report dated April 7, 2016.

Mayor McCullough inquired about the progress of the installation of a traffic light at the intersection of Ocean Heights Avenue and Blackman Road. Administrator Miller advised Atlantic County is currently awaiting adoption of our capital ordinance.

NJ Transportation Trust Fund - Ridge Avenue

Township Engineer Mott advised the township was successful in obtaining a \$196,000 grant for the 3rd phase of Ridge Avenue improvements. This phase will extend improvements well past the bridge. However, there may be a gap between the bridge and the LaCosta sub-division. In the future, Engineer Mott said that he would like to include improvements to Doughty Road due to the amount of truck traffic on this roadway. There was a brief discussion regarding the structural integrity of the

bridge on Ridge Avenue. Engineer Mott advised that he is currently waiting for the county to report on the condition of the bridge including a guide rail design. Mr. Mott stated that he is concerned about liability and any exposure to the township and would not make any improvements to the bridge until he receives the county report.

Township Engineer Mott advised today is the deadline to file for the Flood Hazard Risk Reduction and Resiliency Grant Program which covers improvements to West Atlantic City Bulkhead project. Resolution No. 229 listed on the Supplemental Agenda authorizes the application. Our portion of the joint application with the City of Pleasantville is \$3 million. Pleasantville revised their application to limit improvements to public domain and not include private properties due to potential issues. Their portion is \$2 million. Engineer Mott felt the township has a strong application and expects approvals will be awarded in June.

Mayor McCullough led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Presentations

Mayor McCullough called upon Construction Official, Pat Naticchione and presented him with a Proclamation recognizing May 2016 as Building Safety Month.

General Public Discussion

Mayor McCullough announced he received a request from several individuals who requested to speak about the heroin epidemic. The Mayor said he invited Municipal Court Judge, Robert Switzer to attend this meeting as Chair of the Municipal Alliance to speak about the Alliance's role in addressing drug use.

Bill Schmincke, addressed the Township Committee advising his son, Steven died 24 days ago from a heroin overdose. Mr. Schmincke said that many other residents have experienced similar heartache and he is here to raise public awareness of this epidemic. Mr. Schmincke said heroin is inexpensive and easily accessible.

Committeeman Cafero commented drug addiction and mental illness are diseases and should be treated with the same respect as cancer and diabetes. There should not be a stigma attached to these illnesses and society needs to better be informed about these issues.

Mr. Schmincke said the government at all levels is not prepared for this particular epidemic. There are many steps needed to institute funding to help establish programs to deal with this problem.

Judge Switzer advised the Municipal Alliance deals with education and prevention of drug use through our school system. Their goal is to teach children from an early age that illegal drugs are no good. Their program is dependent on funding. As municipal judge, he stated the Egg Harbor Township is the most proactive Police Department locally on the war on drugs. Judge Switzer noted that heroin is very cheap, accessible and has become the drug of choice. Heroin addiction leads to other problems such as shoplifting to support a habit. Unfortunately, heroin addiction is not just a local problem, but an international issue.

Mayor McCullough provided Mr. Schmincke with copies of a brochure distributed by the police department to individuals with drug issues advising where assistance can be found. He invited a member of Mr. Schmincke’s group to join the Municipal Alliance. He suggested they also contact the Atlantic County Board of Freeholders to share their concerns.

Committeewoman Pfrommer suggested they continue to request local newspapers to print article’s on this topic in order to raise community awareness. Mrs. Pfrommer also advised there is a drug drop off box located in the police department where individuals can securely dispose of unwanted drugs.

Mr. Schmincke stated there are several motels in the township where he believes drug use is prevalent. Deputy Mayor Hodson advised the police department is aware of these locations. However, it would be helpful to share any information directly to the police.

Regina Wittenweiler, 201 Fisler Avenue said heroin use is not limited to young adults or certain classes of people. It is being used by people of all ages and walks of life, it is an epidemic that needs to be addressed.

David Haden, Egg Harbor Township thanked the township committee for hearing their concerns over the use of heroin and allowing the surviving families to speak tonight.

Tammy Schmincke asked if any funding is available to establish sober living houses. She explained that when an individual leaves rehab it is important that they have a safe environment to go to in order to continue to receive support. Her goal is to establish such a place named Steven’s House in memory of her son.

Mayor McCullough asked Judge Switzer if any funding is available. Judge Switzer said funds are very limited. He noted this is a national issue which needs to be addressed by Congress. Mayor McCullough suggested they approach the Assembly and Senate beginning with Senator Whelan.

Capital Ordinances

Township Administrator advised he had nothing further to report on this matter.

Community Center Mechanical Consultant

Township Administrator Miller reported he solicited proposals for evaluations on the HVAC system. The most favorable quote was from Concorde Atlantic and a purchase order has been issued for just under \$14,000. A resolution is not required and he anticipates receiving a report from the vendor within 60 days.

Performance Guarantees

Township Administrator Miller referred to Ordinance 14 introduced earlier in the meeting which eliminates the requirement to post ten percent cash surety as part of the a commercial site plan performance guaranty.

Oak Tree Plaza

Township Administrator Miller advised Resolution 230 listed on the Supplemental Agenda authorizes the Mayor and Township Clerk to execute a Developers Agreement with Oak Tree Plaza. This agreement is required as part of the New Jersey Department of Transportation's condition to allow the public to utilize the road between the Black Horse Pike and Old Egg Harbor Road.

WHEREAS, our Township’s continuing efforts to address the critical issues of safety, energy efficiency, water conservation, and resilience in the built environment that affect our citizens, both in everyday life and in times of natural disaster, give us confidence that our structures are safe and sound, and

WHEREAS, our confidence is achieved through the devotion of vigilant guardians—building safety and fire prevention officials, architects, engineers, builders, tradespeople, laborers and others in the construction industry—who work year-round to ensure the safe construction of buildings, and

ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$3,230,000 AND AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF \$3,000,000 BONDS OR NOTES OF THE TOWNSHIP FOR VARIOUS IMPROVEMENTS OR PURPOSES AUTHORIZED TO BE UNDERTAKEN BY THE TOWNSHIP OF EGG HARBOR

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Egg Harbor, in the County of Atlantic, New Jersey (not less than two thirds of all the members thereof affirmatively concurring), as follows:

SECTION 1: The Township of Egg Harbor, in the County of Atlantic, State of New Jersey (hereinafter referred to as "Township") hereby authorizes the improvements and acquisitions described in Section 3(A) of this Bond Ordinance (hereinafter referred to as "Purposes") to be undertaken by the Township as general improvements the costs of which shall be borne by the Township at large. For the Purposes described in Section 3(A) the Township hereby appropriates the sum of \$3,230,000 including the sum of \$230,000 as the down payments required by the Local Bond Law. It is hereby determined and stated that the amount of the down payment is not less than five percent (5%) of the obligations authorized by this Bond Ordinance and that the amount appropriated as a down payment has been made available prior to final adoption of this Bond Ordinance by provisions in prior or current budgets of the Township for capital improvements and down payments, including also monies received from the United States of America, the State of New Jersey or the County of Atlantic, or agencies thereof, as grants in aid of financing said improvements or purposes.

SECTION 2: In order to finance the cost of the Purposes not covered by application of the down payments, negotiable bonds are hereby authorized to be issued by the Township in the principal amount of \$3,000,000 pursuant to the Local Bond Law. In anticipation of the issuance of the bonds, negotiable bond anticipation notes are hereby authorized to be issued by the Township pursuant to and within the limitations prescribed by the Local Bond Law.

SECTION 3: A. The purposes hereby authorized and for which the bonds are to be issued, the estimated cost of each Purpose and the appropriation therefore, the estimated maximum amount of bonds or notes to be issued for each Purpose and the period of usefulness of each Purpose are as follows:

B. The excess of the appropriation made for each of the aforesaid Purposes over the estimated maximum amount of bonds or notes to be issued therefore, as above stated, namely an aggregate amount of \$230,000 is the amount of the down payments for said Purposes.

C. The estimated cost of each Purpose is equal to the amount of the appropriation herein made therefore.

SECTION 4: All bond anticipation notes issued hereunder shall mature at such times as may be determined by the Chief Financial Officer, provided that no note shall mature later than one year from its date. The notes shall bear interest at such rate or rates and be in such form as may be determined by the Chief Financial Officer. The Chief Financial Officer shall determine all matters in connection with notes issued pursuant to this bond ordinance, and the Chief Financial Officer's signature upon the notes shall be conclusive evidence as to all such determinations. All notes issued hereunder may be renewed from time to time subject to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 40A:2-8(a). The Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to sell part or all of the notes from time to time at public or private sale and to deliver them to the purchasers therefore upon receipt of payment of the purchase price plus accrued interest from their dates to the date of delivery thereof. The Chief Financial Officer is directed to report in writing to the governing body at the meeting next succeeding the date when any sale or delivery of the notes pursuant to this bond ordinance is made. Such report must include the amount, the description, the interest rate and the maturity schedule of the notes sold, the price obtained and the name of the purchaser.

SECTION 5: The Township hereby certifies that it has adopted a capital budget. The applicable capital budget of the Township is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this bond ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency herewith. The resolution in the form promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing full detail of the amended capital budget and capital program as approved by the Director of the Division of Local Government Services is on file with the Township Clerk and available for public inspection.

SECTION 6: The following additional matters are hereby determined, declared, recited and stated:

A. The Purposes described in Section 3(A) of this bond ordinance are not current expenses. They are improvements and an acquisition that the Township may lawfully undertake as capital projects and general improvements, and no part of the cost hereof has been or shall be specially assessed on property specially benefitted thereby.

B. The period of usefulness of the Purposes within the limitations of the Local Bond Law, according to the reasonable life thereof computed from the date of the bonds authorized by this bond ordinance, is 10.63 years.

C. The Supplemental Debt Statement required by the Local Bond Law has been duly prepared and filed in the office of the Township Clerk, and an executed copy has been electronically signed and filed in the office of the Director of the Division of Local Government Services in the Department of Community Affairs of the State of New Jersey. Such statement shows that the gross debt of the Township as defined in the Local Bond Law is increased by the Township as defined in the Local Bond Law is increased by the authorization of the bonds and notes provided for in this bond ordinance by \$3,000,000. The obligations authorized herein will be within all debt limitations prescribed by the Local Bond Law.

D. Amounts not exceeding TWENTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$20,000) in the aggregate for interest on said obligations, costs of issuing said obligations, architectural, engineering and inspection costs, legal expenses, a reasonable proportion of the compensation and expenses of employees of the Township in connection with the acquisition of such improvements and property as authorized herein, and other items of expense listed in and permitted under Section 40A:2-20 of the Local Bond Law have been included as part of the costs of said improvements and are included in the foregoing estimates thereof.

SECTION 7: Any funds received from the County of Atlantic, the State of New Jersey or the United States of America, or any of their agencies, shall be applied either to the direct payment of the cost of such Purposes, or to the payment of the bonds or bond anticipation notes issued pursuant to this bond hereunder and shall be reduced to the extent that such funds are so applied.

SECTION 8: The Township intends to finance the cost of the Purposes with an issue of tax-exempt bonds or bond anticipation notes in an amount not to exceed \$3,000,000. Costs of the Purposes that are properly payable prior to the issuance of the bonds or notes are reasonably expected to be paid initially from revenue. Revenues are available for this purpose only on a temporary and short-term basis pursuant to the budget of the Township, and there are no other funds available for this purpose on a long-term basis. The Township intends to reimburse itself for such costs from the proceeds of its bonds or notes. No cost of the Purposes to be reimbursed with the proceeds of bonds or notes is a cost of working capital. This public notice is a declaration of official intent pursuant to Treasury Regulations §1.103-18 of the United States Treasury.

SECTION 9: The full faith and credit of the Township are hereby pledged to the punctual payment of the principal of and the interest on the bonds or bond anticipation notes authorized by this bond ordinance, and the amounts required for such payments shall in each year, while any of said bonds or notes are outstanding, be included in the annual budget. The bonds or notes shall be direct, unlimited obligations of the Township, and the Township shall be obligated to levy ad valorem taxes upon all the taxable real property within the Township for the payment of the obligations and the interest thereof without limitation as to rate or amount.

SECTION 10: This bond ordinance shall take effect twenty (20) days after the first publication hereof after final adoption, as provided by the Local Bond Law.

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 198 OF THE TOWNSHIP CODE ENTITLED "SUBDIVISION OF LAND AND SITE PLAN REVIEW"

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Committee for the Township of Egg Harbor, County of Atlantic and State of New Jersey that:

SECTION 1: Chapter 6 of the Township Code, specifically Section 198-19J is hereby amended by deleting it in its entirety and replacing it with the following:

§198-19 Performance Guarantee for Improvements

J. Performance guaranties shall be submitted in favor of the Township of Egg Harbor in an amount not to exceed 120% of the cost of installation of the improvements it may deem necessary or appropriate. For subdivisions and residential site plans, ten (10) percent of the total performance guaranty shall be in cash deposited with the Township Clerk and the remaining one hundred ten (110) percent in a form acceptable to the Township Solicitor. Commercial site plans shall post one hundred (100) percent of their performance guaranty in the form acceptable to the Township Solicitor.

SECTION 2: All ordinances or parts of ordinances which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are, to the extent of such inconsistency, hereby repealed.

SECTION 3: Should any section, clause, sentence, phrase or provision of this Ordinance be declared unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance shall take effect upon final passage, adoption and publication in the manner prescribed by law.
