Meeting with Township Engineer Mott

Engineer Mott had nothing to report at this time.

New Business

Purchasing Cooperative

Administrator Miller referred to Resolution 233 authorizing the Township to participate in the National Joint Powers Alliance Cooperative Purchasing Program. He said our participation will enable us to purchase a Rear Load Body at a cost of \$53,475.68 without formally going out to bid.

2 Hartford Drive Tax Assessment Adjustment

Administrator Miller explained the owner of 2 Hartford Drive filed a tax appeal in 2015 with the Atlantic County Board of Taxation. The board reduced the assessment by \$3,000 (\$363,200 to \$360,000). The owner further appealed to the New Jersey Tax Court and an additional reduction of \$17,000 was made to the assessment (\$360,000 to \$343,000). The court's decision was received too late for the Tax Assessor to make the adjustment in 2015 and taxes were paid based off of the old assessment. Therefore, Resolution 234 of 2016 listed as a consent calendar item authorizes the 2015 Tax Assessment Adjustment and allows a credit to be applied in 2015 for any tax overpayment received.

Mayor McCullough commented on the cost associated with filing a tax appeal and the presumption that the reduction will be a large savings. He explained that residents are paying more money to file the appeal than the tax savings, which in most appeals is only a couple of dollars.

Other Business

Supplemental Agenda

Administrator Miller referred to Resolution 241 authorizing grant submittal to the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection, Green Acres Program, for the Recreation Trail Program and advised that this is a second grant for the program. Resolution 243 is temporarily prohibiting traffic on all roadways intersecting with Zion Road between Marshall Drive and Dorset Avenue on the northern side and between Almond Avenue and Hilltop Lane on the southern side of the roadway on May 21, 2016 from 9:00 am to 10:00 pm. He explained that the Atlantic Christian School is hosting a MusicFest featuring a nationally recognized Christian music band, MercyMe. They are expecting 6,000 guests to attend. The police department recommended Marshall Drive, Almond Avenue, Evergreen Avenue, Willow Avenue, Larch Avenue, Dorset Avenue and Hilltop Lane to be closed to vehicle traffic and a parking ban to alleviate traffic congestion and keep pedestrians safe. Offsite parking is available with shuttle service.

Deputy Township Clerk Hughes read the Video Broadcast/Television Statement.

General Public Discussion

Les Nijakowski, 26 Lenape Drive said his neighbor at 30 Lenape Drive has multiple property maintenance violations. Last week the residents on Lenape Drive advised Administrator Miller in writing of their concerns. Administrator Miller reported that our Construction Official had the property inspected and did not find what the residents had listed in their complaint. Mr. Nijakowski did not agree with Administrator Miller’s response. He also complained about Riddle Avenue. He said the road is in horrible condition. Engineer Mott plans on having the owners of Mercedes Benz patch the roadway when they pave their lot and then after the project is complete they will be required to pave the road. Gary Campbell, Jr., 28 Lenape Drive expressed his concerns and added that it’s also a safety issue. Mayor McCullough said that after the meeting he would go with Deputy Mayor Hodson to look at the property.

Joe Dixon, 33 Ravenwood Drive, referred to Ordinance 15 to add a clarification to the measurement of the weight of the vehicles that the governing body introduced earlier in the meeting. He knows that his neighbor filed a complaint about his truck. He asked for clarification on the ordinance. Administrator Miller and Mr. Dixon to discuss further between now and the public hearing. Mr.

Dixon also asked if the Township Code includes rules for security cameras and drones. He had an issue with a neighbor that has since been rectified, but since he was in attendance figured he would bring the topic up. The Township does not currently have a code regulating them, but members of the governing body felt it should look into.

Reports

Township Committee:

Committeeman Finnerty said Saturday’s Community Pride Day was successful; a couple hundred volunteers went through various neighborhoods picking up trash. He said we are very fortunate to have so many volunteers.

Committeeman Cafero reported on the Greate Egg Harbour Township Historical Society’s 2nd Place win for their pictorial history book of Egg Harbor Township, “A Journey Through Time”. He added that this is a great book that June Sheridan and Lynn Wood compiled. Also, the Egg

Harbor Township High School won a Green Ribbon Award, placing within the top 50 in the United States. The award is based on reducing environmental impact and costs, improving health and wellness, and providing effective environmental education. As well as, the Egg Harbor Township High School Key Club attended the New Jersey District Convention this year and were recipients of rewards and recognitions.

Deputy Mayor Hodson echoed Committeeman Finnerty’s comments regarding Saturday’s cleanup day. The Nature Reserve was also a location for clean up, but he commented that people do it on their own and don’t just wait for the one day. He also reminded residents of the Memorial Day Parade, Monday, May 30th starting at 9:00 am and urged those who wish to participate to visit our website or contact his office to register.

Committeewoman Pfrommer thanked everyone who came out and cleaned up on Saturday. She said we also shredded over 8,000 lbs of paper at the Shred-It Event. Mrs. Pfrommer reminded residents that our website, ehtgov.org has current traffic advisories.

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 213 OF THE TOWNSHIP CODE ENTITLED "VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC"

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Committee for the Township of Egg Harbor, County of Atlantic and State of New Jersey that:

SECTION 1: Chapter 213-16 of the Township Code of the Township of Egg Harbor, is hereby amended by deleting the title in its entirety and replacing it as follows:

§213-16 Parking of trucks weighing in excess of 12,000 pounds Gross Vehicle Weight Rating (GVWR)

SECTION 2: Chapter 213-16 of the Township Code of the Township of Egg Harbor, is hereby amended by deleting paragraph A it in its entirety and replacing it with the following:

- A. No person, firm, or corporation shall park a truck, tractor, trailer or omnibus, having a weight in excess of 12,000 pounds Gross Vehicle Weight Rating (GVWR), on any street located in a nonresidential zone in the Township between the hours of 9:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m., prevailing time, of any day.

SECTION 3: Chapter 213-16 of the Township Code of the Township of Egg Harbor, is hereby amended by deleting paragraph B it in its entirety and replacing it with the following:

- B. No person, firm or corporation shall park a truck, tractor, trailer or omnibus, having a weight in excess of 12,000 pounds Gross Vehicle Weight Rating (GVWR), on any street in any residential zone in the Township.

SECTION 4: All ordinances or parts of ordinances which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are, to the extent of such inconsistency, hereby repealed.

SECTION 5: Should any section, clause, sentence, phrase or provision of this Ordinance be declared unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 6: This Ordinance shall take effect upon final passage, adoption and publication in the manner prescribed by law.
