Mayor McCullough called the meeting to order, 5:00 pm.

Closed Session

The Township Committee did not convene into a Closed Executive Session and Resolution No. 266-2016 is void.

Meeting with Township Engineer Mott

Engineer Mott reported he has received numerous complaints in regards to the clearing of trees at the Walmart site. He said all clearing is within the limits of the approved plans. They are two weeks away from having the two buildings demolished. Committeeman Hodson questioned where all the debris is going. Engineer Mott responded, what is not recyclable will be sent to the landfill. They anticipate a completion date of late next summer. Engineer Mott believes it will take closer to 18 months.

Engineer Mott said his office will be advertising all capital projects next week for bids to be accepted in July. He feels doing it earlier in the year will help with the seasonal projects that need to be completed prior to the winter months.

New Business

2015 Municipal Audit

Administrator Miller advised that the 2015 Municipal Audit was distributed last week to the Township Committee. Resolution No. 268 listed this evening certifies to the Local Finance Board that the Governing Body has reviewed the 2015 Annual Audit Recommendation. There are no recommendations this year. Committeeman Cafero commented that with the size of our municipality, having no recommendations is terrific.

ABC License Renewals

Administrator Miller advised that Resolution 269 authorizing renewal of alcoholic beverage plenary retail consumption licenses for July 1, 2016 to June 30, 2017 was updated earlier today and provided to committee members. All plenary retail consumption licenses are eligible for renewal tonight, except Wood Spirits d/b/a

Econolodge. The licensee will need to file an ad-interim application with the state in order to serve alcohol after June 30th. Administrator Miller explained the ad-interim application.

Administrator Miller referred to Resolution No. 272 listed on the consent calendar authorizing renewal of alcoholic beverage plenary retail consumption license issued to Henricat, LLC (c/o Lennard Hammerschlag) for the licensing period of July 1, 2016 to June 30, 2017 where Special Ruling has been obtained (0108-33-023-004). Mr. Hammerschlag has been unable to move forward with his project where the license would be used due to a downturn in economy. He filed for a Special Ruling and obtained it for this reason.

Sale of ABC "D" License

Administrator Miller reported on the public auction that was held on June 15th for a new Plenary Retail Distribution License. The minimum bid was set at \$275,000. There were a total of three (3) bidders and Brooke Stromfeld d/b/a Hela Industries, Inc. was the highest bidder with a final bid of \$420,000. Resolution No. 273 listed on the consent calendar is authorizing acceptance of her bid proposal.

Sale of Block 5205, Lot 42 (Res 248)

Administrator Miller advised that there was a typo on the agenda and it should read lot 42. He explained that the committee previously adopted Resolution No. 248 authorizing the sale of Block 5205, Lot 42 and setting the sale date. The Mainland Journal failed to publish the resolution and therefore we did not meet the statutory requirements to hold the sale. Resolution No. 279 listed on the consent calendar supersedes Resolution 248 of 2016 and authorizes the sale and sets the new public auction date of Thursday, July 14, 2016, at 10:00 am in the Township of Egg Harbor Municipal Building, Conference Room 108.

Block 5114, Lot 2

Administrator Miller said he received a request to purchase Block 5114, Lot 2 from the homeowner directly in front of the property. He explained that it is a 14,000 sq. ft. piece of property, assessed at \$4,900 and located on Homewood Road. It is not a buildable lot and it would only make the adjoining property owners lot larger. Township Committee had no objection and an ordinance will be introduced at the July meeting authorizing the sale.

Other Business

Add-On Resolutions (Supplemental)

A supplemental agenda has been distributed for Resolution's 287 thru 290. Administrator Miller said he received a late request from Doebly and Dad to refund Curb and Sidewalk Permit for property located on Dogwood Avenue and asked that committee add this to the supplemental consent calendar as Resolution 291 when approving.

Ginger McGlinchey, 7 Sunset Boulevard asked if the Township is actively pursuing the Community Rating System with FEMA for flood insurance purposes. Administrator Miller advised that he was told by Pat Griggs from FEMA that approval should occur sometime in October 2016. Mrs. McGlinchey said her flood insurance is extremely high and even a 10% reduction would help immensely. She asked Administrator Miller to supply her with a letter outlining the Township's status.

Amy Frick, 27 Seaview Drive said Risley's Channel has had quite a significant change in tide cycles. She's been in her house 20 years and most recently the tides are causing erosion and water to come up onto the

roadway. Her concern is the compromising of the roadway from water undermining. Mayor McCullough said she's referring to private property. Engineer Mott said if it is affecting our ROW, we may be able to get grant funding. He will look into the matter. Mayor McCullough said there's a similar situation in Anchorage Poynte; a flapper is needed on the outflow pipe.

Deputy Township Clerk Hughes read the Video Broadcast/Television Statement.

Reports

Township Committee:

Committeewoman Pfrommer reported on Music and Movies at the Park and referred residents to check out the listing of events scheduled on our website.

Deputy Mayor Hodson said this year for the first time the Memorial Day Ceremony had to be moved indoors and no parade was held due to rain. He said it worked out and if weather brings them indoors again, it will be held there, but he prefers the outdoor ceremony and parade. The Veterans Advisory Board also hosted a Flag Day Ceremony on June 14th at Veterans Memorial Park. Deputy Mayor Hodson congratulated the Egg Harbor Township High School Class of 2016 and apologized for missing the ceremony due to a scheduled vacation. He further congratulated all the softball players on their successful season.

Committeeman Cafero reported on a grant the Township secured for \$380,000 from the Department of Community Affairs as part of Phase II of the Sandy Planning Grant Program (News Release dated June 22, 2016 attached to minutes). Further, congratulated the Class of 2016.

General Public Discussion

Brenda Pileggi, 55 Windsor Drive in Delilah Oaks said she is in attendance with many of her neighbors to complain about the traffic in her neighborhood. A lengthy discussion followed in regards to the speeding motorists and additional traffic. Deputy Hodson said the governing body fought the change on the Black Horse Pike, but didn't win. Ms. Pileggi suggested one-way traffic from Fernwood Avenue, no left on Windsor Avenue. Administrator Miller advised the residents that a petition would need to be filed and a minimum of 60% of the residents need to sign it in order to introduce/adopt an ordinance to make the roadway one-way.

Ada Gaud, 1 Windsor Drive questioned how long it would take before Windsor Drive would be one-way. Administrator Miller advised that if they residents provide the Township with a petition by July 8th, then an ordinance could be considered for introduction at the July 20th meeting followed by a public hearing at the August 17th meeting and effective around Labor Day.

Police Chief Davis said he receives traffic complaints often, but he has to have tangible data. He said quite often, the biggest offenders are those that live on the street.

Ms. Gaud suggested that while the residents have to wait the 90 days for an ordinance to take effect, could the police department show more presence on a Friday night when the out of towners come through.

Lynette Adkisson, 53 Kingsley Drive said she is constantly calling the police about illegal activity; young adults in abandoned homes. She suggests the properties be secured better.

RESOLUTION SUPERSEDING RESOLUTION 248 OF 2016 AND DECLARING CERTAIN CURRENTLY OWNED PUBLIC PROPERTY TO BE NO LONGER NECESSARY FOR PUBLIC PURPOSES AND AUTHORIZING AND SETTING PUBLIC AUCTION WITH ADJACENT PROPERTY OWNERS HAVING RIGHT TO FIRST REFUSAL OF SAID PROPERTIES, WHICH OFFERS FOR SAID PROPERTIES WILL BE RECEIVED ON THURSDAY, JULY 14, 2016, AT 10:00 AM IN THE TOWNSHIP OF EGG HARBOR MUNICIPAL BUILDING, CONFERENCE ROOM 108

WHEREAS, Township Committee adopted Resolution 248 of 2016 at their May 25, 2016 meeting offering Block 5205, Lot 42 for sale; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A12-13(a) requires notice of public action to be published once a week for two (2) consecutive weeks; and

WHEREAS, the Mainland Journal published the notice on June 1, 2016 but neglected to publish the notice on June 8, 2016; and

WHEREAS, as a result of their failures to public the second notice, the process must commence again from the beginning; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:12-13 (a) authorizes a municipality to sell by public sale at auction, real property which it determined is no longer necessary for public municipal purposes; and

WHEREAS, the properties listed in Exhibit A are no longer needed for any municipal purposes by the Township of Egg Harbor;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Egg Harbor, County of Atlantic and State of New Jersey that:

SECTION 1: SALE TERMS AND PROVISIONS

1. The parcels of real property described on the attached **Exhibit A**, incorporated herein, are declared by the Township Committee to be not necessary for public municipal purposes and that the best interest of the public shall be served in selling said properties by public sale at auction to the highest offer at or above the minimum price set forth on **Exhibit A**; with the Township Committee reserving the right to accept or reject or otherwise remove a property from sale; on Thursday, July 14, 2016, in *Conference Room 108* at the Egg Harbor Township Municipal Building, at 10:00 a.m., prevailing time.

2. As to any undersized lots listed in **Exhibit A**, they shall be first offered to the adjoining property owner at the minimum price appearing in **Exhibit A**. If there be more than one adjacent owner, then the property shall be sold to the highest bidder among adjoining property owners. If no adjoining property owner bids on the property, then it shall be open to full public bidding.

3. A deposit of 10 percent of the minimum price for real property must be paid in cash or by certified bank check by the successful bidder at the time of the offer; said time and place set forth herein. This deposit shall be made subject to return in the event of rejection of said offer. The balance, together with the costs of sale and legal expenses must be paid at closing in cash or by certified bank check.

4. These costs of sale described in paragraph 3 above, shall include, but are not limited to, legal expenses, title search fees, insurance fees, appraisal fees, survey fees, recording fees, and any such other costs of sale; but this shall not obligate the Township to incur these expenses or provide these services. The successful bidder shall be responsible for any and all such costs. The Township reserves the right upon completion of the sale to accept or reject the highest bids made at the public sale; which acceptance or rejection shall be made no longer than the second regular meeting of the Township Committee following the sale.

5. Upon acceptance of a bid and payment of all costs and expenses related thereto, the Township of Egg Harbor shall issue a Bargain and Sale Deed; without covenants; to the successful and accepted bidder. The deed shall contain restrictive covenants that said premises shall not be used for a landfill, sand pit, gravel pit, a piggery or for the business of raising pigs. Should the said lot or lots to be conveyed be undersized and do not conform to zoning lot size requirements, then they are to be conveyed subject to a further covenant in the deed restricting use of the lot or lots for building purposes until such time as the purchaser causes the lot or lots to conform to current zoning, either through an appropriate variance action, or by meeting lot size requirements by joining a sufficient number of parcels of real property to conform to the lot size requirements as well as to any and all other zoning requirements.

6. The parcels shall be subject to all restrictions, covenants, easements, rights of way, exceptions, liens; whether any or all are known or unknown and whether or not of record. No representations, covenants, promises, or warranties are made by the Township of Egg Harbor as to title, and responsibility for determining clear and marketable title rests solely with the bidders who shall govern themselves accordingly. The properties in question shall otherwise be sold subject to all existing Federal, State, County and Municipal laws, including, but not limited to, current zoning, health, and planning laws; rules and regulations.

7. Settlement between the Township of Egg Harbor and the successful bidders shall take place on or before August 31, 2016. The Township shall be solely obligated to tender a Bargain and Sale Deed; without covenants; with restrictions stated herein; and a certified copy of the sale resolution.

8. The sale authorized by this resolution shall be contingent upon and subject to the right of first refusal granted, pursuant to New Jersey statutes to contiguous real property owners to the subject real property for auction sale; said right to be exercised in accordance with Paragraph 2 herein.

9. Offers may be made by an individual, corporation, or governmental entity; with any or all acting on their own behalf. Offers may also be submitted by a prospective purchaser's attorney, real estate agent or broker or other authorized representative; although no commission shall be payable by the Township of Egg Harbor to any real estate broker or other authorized representative of a purchaser in connection with any sale or property by the Township.

10. The Township Committee shall also have a period of time to reconsider said resolution not later than 30 days after the final passage and advertisement of said resolution. This shall include the right to terminate any auction sale, revoke a property from the auction sale list, and any monies paid by a bidder through to that time will be refunded if the Township Committee does exercise its right to not accept bids or otherwise remove a property from the public sale auction list.

11. The Township Clerk is hereby directed to file with the Director of the Division of Local Government Services in the Department of Community Affairs for the State of New Jersey, the required sworn affidavit verifying the publication of advertisements required by statute applicable to this Resolution and the sale of municipal public property.
