Meeting with Township Engineer Mott

Road bids

Engineer Mott outlined the report of bids for 3 projects all of which were received July 14, 2016.

Contract 88, FY2016 Municipal Aid-Reconstruction of Ridge Avenue, Phase III, four responsive bids were submitted and recommendation is to award to the lowest bidder, Arawak Paving Company, Inc. once the governor releases funding. This bid totaled \$228,900 and is within \$3,000 of the engineer's estimate.

Contract 89, 2016 Road Program, three responsive bids were received. Resolution No. 297 is listed for consideration tonight to award this contract to the lowest bidder, Arawak Paving Company, Inc. in the amount of \$668,800. This bid is within 20 percent of the engineer's cost estimate. The following roadways will be covered under this contract; portions of Asbury Avenue, Old Zion Road and

Century Drive as well as, Arbor Drive, Scullville Fire House, miscellaneous overlays and drainage and traffic striping.

Contract 90, 2015 CDBG -Wintergreen Avenue and West Jersey Avenue drainage improvements, eight bids were submitted and recommendation is to award to the lowest bidder, South State, Inc. in the amount of \$113,900 once Atlantic County commits to this project.

Delilah Oaks stop signs

Engineer Mott circulated maps of the Delilah Oaks sub-division to township committee in conjunction with Ordinances 23 and 24 which are listed for introduction this evening. Administrator Miller reviewed the maps explaining Ordinance 23 will delete Kingsley and Windsor Avenues as through streets. Ordinance 24 will establish stop intersections. Mr. Miller said he is hopeful these changes will reduce the resident traffic concerns with speeding motorists. Engineer Mott advised stop bars will also be painted onto the roadway together with the 25 mph speed limit. He commented rumble strips may also be helpful. Committeeman Finnerty said rumble strips may not be needed and noted that GPS has recently directed many motorists into this development. He also hopes the proposed changes will rectify the residents traffic concerns.

Mayor McCullough inquired about the status of signalization at the intersection of Blackman Road and Ocean Heights Avenue. Engineer Mott replied the county just recently inquired and confirmed that Administrator Miller is Egg Harbor Township's contact. Mayor McCullough asked Administrator Miller to reach out to the county in an effort to move this project forward.

New Business

Land Donations

23 Brown Avenue (Block 1702, Lot 52)

Administrator Miller advised Ordinance 21 listed on the agenda for consideration tonight, provides for the acceptance of a donation of property from the Estate of George A. Berbetto. Township Committee had no objection and will act upon Ordinance 21 later in the meeting.

710 Dogwood Avenue (Block 3423, Lot 30 and Seton Avenue (Block 4001, Lot 47)

Administrator Miller said individual property owners wish to donate these parcels, both of which are located in the De Carlo tract. The taxes are less than \$100 for each lot. Township Committee had no objections.

106 Ruckreim Drive (Block 1114, Lot 49)

Administrator Miller advised this property owner also wishes to donate their land. He further advised the township owns other land in this area and could possibly accumulate enough property to have a buildable lot in the future. Township Committee had no objections.

Park hours

Administrator Miller said Ordinance 20 listed for introduction will establish opening and closing hours for the Shires Park and Tot Lot. Township Committee had no objections.

GWU Salary Ordinance amendment

Administrator Miller reported an error was discovered in the GWU salary for Category D, Level 7 employees. Ordinance 22 is listed for introduction to amend the GWU salary ordinance. Township Committee had no objections.

Law Enforcement Support Office (LESO) 1033 Program

Administrator Miller said Police Chief and Emergency Management Coordinator Davis has requested the township to participate in the Federal Government Program which offers surplus military equipment for use in emergency situations. Township Committee had no objections.

Police Explorer trailer

Administrator Miller referred to Resolution 303 authorizing the transfer of a trailer from the Township of Egg Harbor to the Egg Harbor Township Police Explorer Post. Mr. Miller explained passage of this resolution would return the trailer to the Explorers and allow them to sell the trailer and realize the profits.

Target Ranges on private property

Administrator Miller said he has received complaints over target practice occurring in residential areas. The township has the ability to regulate or prohibit this type of activity in residential areas. The code currently provides for a 450' distance limitation between structures in a residential area. Committeeman Cafero stated he was not in favor of target practice in a residential area. Mayor McCullough requested a sample ordinance be circulated for township committee's review and further discussion at a later date.

ACIA Pool Loan Program

Administrator Miller advised Atlantic County has offered the township to participate in a pooled loan program which would provide significant savings to the township. Township Committee had no objections and corresponding resolutions will be listed on the August Township Committee Meeting agenda.

Other Business

Administrator Miller reviewed the Supplemental Agenda, Resolutions 320 through 322 by title.

Mayor McCullough led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Presentations

Mayor McCullough called upon Michael T. Hughes, Jr. to recognize him for 25 years of valued service to Egg Harbor Township. Chief Davis personally thanked Lieutenant Hughes for his dedication to the Egg Harbor Township Police Department.

Police Chief Davis announced National Night Out activities will be held August 2, 2016 at Veterans Memorial Park and encouraged the public to participate and show support for our officers.

Lloyd Humphrey presented Township Committee with a plaque for their cooperation with the annual Multiple Sclerosis City to Shore Ride. This year's event will be held on September 24 and 25, 2016.

Mayor McCullough recognized Egg Harbor Township School Board member, Justin Riggs and announced that a Special Meeting will be held tomorrow evening in town hall with New Jersey Senate President Sweeny. The purpose of the meeting will be to discuss ways to help with the high cost of operating the township's schools. Members of the Board of Education will join the Township Committee for this Special Meeting.

Annual Report Presentation

Hector Tavaréz, PAL Executive Director gave a brief presentation on programs offered through the Egg Harbor Township Police Athletic League. Director Tavaréz commented participation is down from 1,000 to 800 and that the majority of participants are from Egg Harbor Township. The football program is no longer being offered as the number of participants was down. Elimination of this program will help support the Egg Harbor Township Youth Organizations Football program. Committeewoman Pfrommer asked if the football equipment was available for purchase. Director Tavaréz advised the Board of Directors will need to determine disbursement of the equipment. Administrator Miller requested the equipment be given to our Recreation Director sooner than September so that the equipment can be refurbished and ready for the upcoming football season. Mayor McCullough requested an annual financial report. Director Tavaréz advised the 2015 audit is still being performed by Ford Scott and Associates. Mayor McCullough emphasized the importance of the governing body's receipt of the audit in a timely manner. Director Tavaréz acknowledged the importance of the audit. Mr. Tavaréz further reported the property at Leap and Ridge Avenues is recovering from the Derecho and Buddy's Adventure Zone is moving forward. Mayor McCullough commented the Egg Harbor Township PAL is a premier Police Athletic League facility.
