MINUTES

Mayor McCullough called the meeting to order, 5:00 p.m.

Township Clerk Tedesco read the Opening Statement Pursuant to the Open Public Meetings Act.

Meeting with Township Engineer Mott

Seaview Harbor Stormwater Easement

Engineer Mott referred to Ordinance 24 scheduled for introduction this evening. The Township has a storm pipe in need of repair that runs through the property of 51 Sunset Boulevard in Seaview Harbor. The pipe is collapsing, causing it to fail. An easement was not prepared when the development was originally constructed, therefore it was necessary for Solicitor Friedman to prepare an easement allowing the Township to repair the pipe. The planned repair consists of a new pipe and yard restoration and work will be done through the 2015 Road Program.

Johnson Avenue and Franklin Avenue Street Vacations

Engineer Mott advised Ordinance 25 and 26 vacating a portion of Johnson Avenue and a portion of Franklin Avenue are needed in conjunction with and recommended by the Planning Board for the new Mercedes Benz dealership. They anticipate breaking ground early September.

Miscellaneous Road Work

Engineer Mott reported county road work has been ongoing for the past week on Ocean Heights Avenue and the traffic unit has not received any complaints from motorists. After settling of underground work, final paving should occur.

South Jersey Gas Company will commence work on West Jersey Avenue August 3rd. Their project is within the shoulder of the roadway and one lane will need to be closed. Motorists will be detoured down Trudy Avenue and they hope to have all work complete before school begins. Discussion followed regarding the detour.

Arawak Paving will begin our state aid funded project on Ridge Avenue Monday, July 27th and all work should be complete within two (2) weeks. The detour will put motorists down Main Avenue. Once the contractor reaches the Main Avenue portion of work, motorists will be directed by police.

Engineer Mott advised bids will be received on August 18th for the 2015 Road Program and he will be recommending Township Committee award the contract at their August 19th meeting. A brief discussion followed in regards to drainage issues and the condition of Stafford Avenue. Also, bids will be received for the Miscellaneous Bond Program which is the three (3) projects Solicitor Friedman was successful on calling on the bonds; Zion Woods, Pennington Estates and Pashley Development. He will recommend awarding this contract at the Township Committee Meeting on August 19th as well. All work should be done by Thanksgiving. In regards to Somers Avenue, no word from the gas company yet. Administrator Miller to follow-up, but the plan is to proceed with paving with or without gas service. Alder Avenue will also be paved as part of this project.

Mayor McCullough said he heard gas lines are being installed on Jeffers Landing Road. Engineer Mott said he has not heard that. Deputy Mayor Hodson said gas is out that way and it may be true.

Engineer Mott referred to the West Atlantic City Demolition project and said it is not moving as fast as everyone hoped for, but the contractor has been very diligent. He is recycling on-site to keep the cost down. The project is halfway complete and should be complete by September.

The West Atlantic City Gabion project is moving along and 50% complete. An anti-graffiti spray will be applied to the wall, which was suggested by a resident. There will be three (3) bridges/walkovers, one of the three will be ADA compliant.

New Business

Dispatch Shared Services Agreements

Administrator Miller referred to Resolution 301, which is an amendment to the City of Northfield agreement decreasing the cost by \$10,000. At the June 24th meeting a resolution was passed to enter into a shared agreement with the Borough of Longport and they are scheduled to adopt their resolution this Saturday. We would take over their dispatch services in September. Administrator Miller referred to the City of Linwood and said once we bring the Borough of Longport on it is his recommendation to proceed in the same manner as was done with the City of Northfield.

Mayor McCullough said he has had discussions with two (2) councilmen from Linwood. They are putting out an RFP for ambulance services. He explained to them that Egg Harbor Township is unable to respond to their RFP due to a couple of the conditions contained in the RFP. Their RFP's are due August 3rd and if Linwood does not receive any acceptable responses, Egg Harbor Township is amicable to discussing terms with a few changes to the current RFP.

Community Development Block Grant Program

Resolution 302 is a renewal of the Community Development Block Grant relationship that we have with Atlantic County through the Atlantic County Improvement Authority. The county is the designated recipient of funding and we receive about \$100,000 per year for projects. Administrator Miller recommends our continued participation.

Sale of Anchorage Poynte Property

Administrator Miller said the Anchorage Poynte homeowners want to form a group and takeover ownership and assume liability of the lagoon because they feel they will have better control if they assume ownership as opposed to the state taking ownership. He said an ordinance could be introduced at the August meeting offering it for sale, then they could form a homeowners association. Mayor McCullough commented that the residents are sincerely interested in taking over ownership of the lagoon.

Other Business

Supplemental Agenda

Resolution 329

Administrator Miller reported estimated tax bills are diligently being worked on by our Tax Office. He is hopeful bills will go out Monday or Tuesday of next week and the grace period will be extended until August 24th. Resolution 329 is listed on the supplemental agenda authorizing the Tax Collector to prepare and mail estimated tax bills. This will allow us to start collecting tax monies, in order to make payments on the Township's August bills due without having to take out a tax anticipation note to bill payments. Administrator Miller is hopeful the county will extend their August 15th payment due date as well.

Mayor McCullough reminded the Township Committee that last year the county tax board forgot to include the library and health tax in their bill, causing a \$700,000 shortfall to the taxpayers of Egg Harbor Township. They were going to credit us in August for our first billing cycle. They have since decided to reduce the health and library tax to each municipality instead of crediting us.

Resolution 330

Administrator Miller referred to Resolution 330 on the supplemental agenda. This resolution authorizes our participation in the Municipal Shared Services Defense Agreement to enter into an agreement with Burchell and other experts from Rutgers in the preparation of a statewide Fair Share Analysis and that the Law Offices of Jeffrey R. Surenian and Associates, LLC will serve as the administrative entity. COAH Attorney Surenian was able to get about thirty-five of his towns together to agree to share these services. The Fair Share Council hired an expert that came up with inflated numbers. We needed to find an independent expert to derive numbers. Our share of the cost is \$2,000.

Resolution 331

Administrator Miller referred to Resolution 331 designating Block 1029, Lot 1 as an area in need of rehabilitation and explained the Planning Board adopted a resolution and now the Township Committee needs to adopt one. This is for the Michael's senior housing application.

Ordinance 27

Administrator Miller explained Ordinance 27 authorizes the acquisition of property known as block 5104, Lot 3, 4 and 5, on Eastwood Avenue, Block 5105, Lot 2 on Wynnewood Road and Block 5108, Lot 4 on Longwood Road owned by Sidney Simon. We own several parcels in the area and it is his recommendation to purchase 2.8 acres of land for \$29,000.

Atlantic County Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan Update

Administrator Miller advised of a flyer he received on Monday from the county. The county has to do this every five years. It has been forwarded to the newspaper and posted on our website. He encouraged residents to look at it since there is a deadline. Committeewoman Pfrommer will advise residents later in the meeting.

Mayor McCullough led the Pledge of Allegiance

Presentations

Mayor McCullough called upon Cathy England, Deputy Tax Collector and presented her with a clock in recognition of her thirty (30) years of dedicated service to Egg Harbor Township.

Assemblyman Chris Brown provided a legislative update including the expansion of casino gaming in North Jersey. He invited residents to attend a Town Hall Meeting which will have a blue panel of experts on the issue. It will be held July 27th from 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. at the Egg Harbor Township Community Center. He encourages everyone to attend.

Committeeman Finnerty asked for an update regarding the PILOT program in Atlantic City. Assemblyman Brown said it's actually called the Casino Tax Stabilization Bill. It is designed to stabilize the taxes for the casinos. It is his position that giving them a \$10 million tax break is a form of corporate welfare on the backs of all the residents. Assemblyman Brown continued to explain his plan. A lengthy discussion followed regarding the impact this bill will cause. Mayor McCullough said he feels Atlantic City should go the same route as corporations and file for Chapter 9, just like Detroit had to do.

Lloyd Humphrey was scheduled to make a presentation to Township Committee on Multiple Sclerosis City to Shore Ride, but was unable to attend.

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General Public Discussion

Nolan Atkinson, Morris Beach resident and taxpayer since 1973 addressed the committee. His house was destroyed in Hurricane Sandy and he and his wife rebuilt. They have a nice new home, but across the street at 1 Jones Avenue is a home that is in deplorable condition. He is here tonight to ask that the Township take appropriate action to rectify issues and possible demolition. He has made numerous calls to the Township for at least a year. Mr. Atkinson handed out photographs to the members of committee. Mrs. Atkinson has filed a complaint with Mr. Naticchione and she has spoken to Inspector Cummings. Inspector Cummings advised that they are in the notification process with the homeowner, which could take several months.

Constance Anderson, Morris Beach resident agreed with Mr. Atkinson’s comments. Mayor McCullough assured the residents he will investigate and have it taken care of. Committeeman Finnerty echoed the Mayor’s guarantee.

Engineer Mott questioned the name Morris Beach vs Jobs Point. Mr. Atkinson said the local name is Morris Beach, but on a Nautical Map it’s labeled as Job’s Point.

Mayor McCullough requested the residents to contact his offices next week for an update on the matter.

Leonard Dagit, 4 Point Drive said the residents of Anchorage Poynte are moving forward to form an association. The Mayor said the Township is ready to move forward. Mr. Dagit will advise Administrator Miller when the association has formed.

Reports

Township Committee:

Committeeman Finnerty reported on National Night Out being held on August 4th from 5:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. at Tony Canale Park. It is a free event, public is welcome. There will be various vendors, games for the kids, police vs fire softball games and a great fireworks display.

Committeeman Cafero complimented Assemblyman Brown for attending tonight’s meeting and giving an update on the Atlantic City issue.

Deputy Mayor Hodson commented on the Atlantic City issue and said there is no quick fix and it’s a bad situation. Regardless of what the governor does or doesn’t do we are going to be impacted. He also reported that this Saturday at the Historical Society on West Jersey Avenue from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. they will be holding the “Call of Duty” event presenting Civil War to present. Also, a reminder that the Wounded Warrior Golf Outing will be held on September 10, 2015.

Mayor McCullough reported that this year will be the 5th year for the Wounded Warrior Project Golf Outing. Over the past four years, this event has raised a lot of funds. The date has been changed from September 11th to September 10th giving New York City firefighters the opportunity to participate. Mayor McCullough publicly thanked various businesses for their support of this event.

Committeewoman Pfrommer reported the last day to have FEMA review your application for Sandy Hurricane claims or if you are not satisfied with your initial response is September 15th. Committeewoman Pfrommer reminded motorists that the eastbound lane of Mill Road will be closed starting July 27th. This closure will be 24/7 through November and she urges an alternate route. Committeewoman Pfrommer congratulated our police department for their 3rd accreditation. We are the only town to receive a 3rd accreditation. Mayor McCullough explained the accreditation process and how important this is and a huge benefit to our residents, particularly in court litigation matters.

Administrator:

Administrator Miller announced that Atlantic County is going through the Hazardous Mitigation Plan Review. They have to do it every 5 years and it is multi-jurisdictional. There is a comment period and he urged committee and residents to visit our website or the county’s website.

WHEREAS, the Township of Egg Harbor Tax Collector in consultation with the Township of Egg Harbor Chief Financial Officer has computed an estimated tax levy in accordance with N.J.S.A. 54:4-66.3, and they have both signed a certification showing the tax levies for the previous year, the tax rates and the range of permitted estimated tax levies; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Egg Harbor, County of Atlantic, and State of New Jersey on the 22nd day of July 2015 as follows:

1. The Township of Egg Harbor Tax Collector is hereby authorized and directed to prepare and issue estimated tax bills for the Township for the third installment of 2015 taxes. The Tax Collector shall proceed and take such actions as are permitted and required by L. 1994, c.72 (N.J.S.A. 54:4-66.2 and 54.4-66.3).
2. The entire estimated tax levy for 2015 is hereby set at \$122,022,780.
3. In accordance with the law the third installment of 2015 taxes shall not be subject to interest until the later of August tenth or the twenty-fifth calendar day after the date the estimated tax bills were mailed. The estimated tax bills shall contain a notice specifying the date on which interest may begin to accrue.

Council on Affordable Housing, 221 N.J. 1 (2015) (the "Supreme Court Decision"); and

WHEREAS, Fair Share Housing Center ("FSHC"), through the services of David Kinsey, has prepared what it considers to be the statewide fair share numbers (the "FSHC Numbers") for use by the 15 vicinage Mt. Laurel Judges to calculate a municipality's affordable housing obligation pursuant to the Supreme Court Decision; and

WHEREAS, by the Township Committee of the Township of Egg Harbor, County of Atlantic and State of New Jersey desires to participate in the preparation of a statewide fair share analysis to be undertaken by Rutgers, The State University of New Jersey ("Rutgers"), through Dr. Robert W. Burchell, Principal Investigator, and various other experts employed by Rutgers in order to establish a rational and reasonable methodology (the "Burchell Fair Share Analysis") for determination of a municipality's obligation to provide a realistic opportunity through its land use ordinances for its fair share of the region's affordable housing needs in accordance with the Mount Laurel Doctrine as set forth in In the Matter of the Adoption of N.J.A.C. 5:96 and 5:97 by the New Jersey Council on Affordable Housing, 221 N.J. 1 (2015) ("Decision") and prior decisions of the Courts of New Jersey, and the Fair Housing Act, N.J.S.A. 52:27D-301 et. seq.; and

WHEREAS, Rutgers, utilizing Dr. Burchell as the Principal Investigator and author has agreed to prepare the Burchell Fair Share Analysis within 90 days of being retained to establish his view of the proper way to determine each municipality's fair share obligation; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Burchell estimates the cost to prepare the initial Burchell Fair Share Analysis will be \$70,000; and

WHEREAS, it is anticipated that there will be a need for Dr. Burchell to analyze any challenges to his conclusions and prepare a rebuttal report to said challenges which is not included in the \$70,000; and

WHEREAS, it is anticipated that if each municipality contributes \$2,000, there will be sufficient monies to pay the cost to prepare the initial Burchell Fair Share Analysis, to analyze any challenges to the Initial Fair Share Analysis and to Prepare a Rebuttal Report given the number of municipalities that have expressed an interest in retaining Burchell; and

WHEREAS, a Municipal Shared Services Defense Agreement (hereinafter MSSDA"), has been prepared (a) so that monies can be collected to enter into an agreement with Rutgers (hereinafter "the Rutgers Agreement") and so that Burchell, along with various other experts from Rutgers, can perform the tasks described above and (b) so that the rights and responsibilities of each municipality that wishes to sign the agreement to retain Rutgers are defined; and

WHEREAS, the MSSDA provides that the Law Offices of Jeffrey R. Surenian and Associates, LLC (“Surenian”) will serve as the administrative entity to sign the Rutgers agreement on behalf of the municipalities that signed the MSSDA and paid the \$2,000 fee; and

WHEREAS, it is imperative given the time constraints for municipalities that wish to retain Burchell to sign the MSSDA and pay the \$2,000 fee so that Burchell can conduct the necessary analysis; and

WHEREAS, notwithstanding the foregoing, it is possible that the MSSDA may need to be changed as a result of ongoing negotiations with the Rutgers agreement following execution of the MSSDA and the payment of the \$2,000 fee; and

WHEREAS, in such an event, any member that objects to the changes that Rutgers may require shall have the opportunity to relinquish membership in the Municipal Group and to receive back the \$2,000 payment as more specifically set forth in the MSSDA.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Egg Harbor, County of Atlantic and State of new Jersey, as follows:

1. The terms and conditions of the MSSDA attached hereto are hereby approved, ratified and confirmed.
2. The amount of \$2,000 is hereby authorized to be expended by the Township Committee of the Township of Egg Harbor, County of Atlantic and State of New Jersey for Rutgers through Dr. Robert Burchell, Principal Investigator to prepare the Burchell Fair Share Analysis.
3. A certification of funds authorizing the aforesaid expenditure has been signed by the Chief Financial Officer of the Township of Egg Harbor and is appended hereto.
4. The Mayor be and is hereby authorized to execute the aforesaid MSSDA to memorialize the participation of the Township of Egg Harbor, County of Atlantic and State of New Jersey in the preparation of the Burchell Fair Share Analysis and to take any and all actions reasonably required to effectuate said Agreement.
5. The Township Committee of the Township of Egg Harbor, County of Atlantic and State of New Jersey hereby authorizes Jeffrey R. Surenian, Esq. to execute on behalf of the Township of Egg Harbor the Research Agreement with Rutgers to initiate and complete Burchell Fair Share Analysis and to do such other actions to effectuate the purposes of said Research Agreement.
6. If further changes to the MSSDA are needed as a result of finalizing the Rutgers Agreement, within ten (10) days of notification by Surenian of the changes, the Township of Egg Harbor will inform Surenian if it objects to the changes and wishes to withdraw from the Municipal Group and obtain a refund of the \$2000 it paid.

RESOLUTION DESIGNATING BLOCK 1029, LOT 1 AS AN AREA IN NEED OF REHABILITATION

WHEREAS, *N.J.S.A.* 40A:12A-14, authorizes the governing body of any municipality, by Resolution, to determine whether, according to the criteria set forth therein, a delineated area is in need of rehabilitation, and that a program of rehabilitation, as defined by *N.J.S.A.* 40A:12A-3 may be expected to prevent further deterioration and promote the overall development of the community; and

WHEREAS, the Township Committee have referred their proposed Resolution to the Planning Board and received the Board's recommendation to declare the properties delineated on the attached chart (hereinafter referred to as the "delineated properties" or "delineated area") as an area in need of rehabilitation;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Township Committee for the Township of Egg Harbor, County of Atlantic, and State of New Jersey that:

1. A significant portion of structures therein are in a deteriorated or substandard condition; and
2. There is a pattern of vacancy, abandonment or underutilization of properties in the delineated area; and
3. A program of rehabilitation as defined in *N.J.S.A.* 40A:12A-3 may be expected to prevent further deterioration and promote overall development of the community; and
4. The delineated properties shown on the attached chart, within the Township of Egg Harbor, are hereby designated as an area in need of rehabilitation according to the criteria of *N.J.S.A.* 40A:12A-14.
