The Mayor called the meeting to Order at 5:03 p.m.

Meeting with Township Engineer Mott

2011 Road Improvement Program Bids

Township Engineer Mott reported 6 bids were submitted and reviewed for completeness. The lowest base bid was submitted by Arawak Paving, Co., Inc. for \$722,000. This bid is approximately 15 percent below the Engineer's Estimate. Resolution 314 to award contract to Arawak Paving Co., Inc. is listed on the Consent Calendar for consideration.

Broadway Tract Street Vacations

Engineer Mott advised Ordinance 28 listed for introduction tonight will vacate a series of dead-end streets in the Broadway Tract which abut township owned properties if approved. Vacation of these streets will allow for consolidation of lots.

2012 NJDOT Municipal Aid Application

Township Engineer Mott advised Resolution 308 listed on the consent calendar authorizes the submission of a \$150,000 grant for the improvement of Reega Avenue from English Creek Avenue to the Hamilton Township line. Mr. Mott feels this section of roadway will qualify for grant criteria due to the high traffic volume.

Old Business

2002 Bond Refinancing

Administrator Miller explained approval of Resolution 305 determining the form and other details of \$5,000,000 general obligation refunding bonds, series 2011 is needed to finalize our bond refinancing. He anticipates completion of this process within the next 4 weeks.

New Business

Best Practices Inventory

Mayor McCullough was pleased to announce that Egg Harbor Township has submitted its application at 98 percent compliance. Administrator Miller explained that part of the process is to discuss this matter publicly and address

any questions or concerns. No questions were raised.

2010 Municipal Audit

Mayor McCullough stated he was also very pleased with the 2010 Audit and noted there were no recommendations. The Mayor acknowledged the Chief Financial Officer and Administrator for their efforts.

Price's Pit - Indemnification and Hold Harmless with Atlantic City Electric

Administrator Miller explained Atlantic City Electric Company executed a Hold Harmless and Indemnification agreement with Egg Harbor Township in 1990 as part of their site plan requirement. The original approval included property within Price's Pit. The federal government now needs a portion of that property as part of the site remediation plan for Price's Pit. Resolution 329 listed for consideration tonight authorizes the partial release of the Hold Harmless and Indemnification agreement for Atlantic City Electric.

Public Works Bids

Basin Maintenance

Administrator Miller advised 3 bids were received and Resolution 316 is listed to award the contract to tge lowest responsible bidder, Turfscapes, LLC. The township is currently responsible for the maintenance of 80 basins and it is most economical to contract this work to a private vendor.

Front End Loaders

Administrator Miller stated 1 bid was received for demo equipment which realizes a savings of approximately \$40,000 over new equipment. Resolution 315 is listed to award contract for 2 used or newer front end loaders to Jesco, Inc.

Rejection of Bids

Rolloff Container

Administrator Miller explained the bidder for the Petersen Lighting Loader, 24 cubic yard trash body for rolloff failed to submit the proper consent of surety and several other required documents. Resolution 317 is listed to reject this bid.

Fire Department Uniforms

Administrator Miller further explained the bidder for the Fire Department Uniforms failed to submit the proper surety documentation. Resolution 318 is listed to reject this bid.

Other Business (not listed on the Agenda)

Deputy Mayor Risley brought to the Township Committee's attention a request from the Recreation Commission to ban smoking in public parks. As an alternative, Deputy Mayor Risley suggested the Governing Body may want to consider establishing a designated smoking area in public parks.

Mayor McCullough was contacted by South Jersey Gas who advised they intend to increase the gas line pressure from Estelle Manor to the gas fields in Egg Harbor Township. The Mayor has advised Fire Chief Danz and requested a detailed letter from the gas company.

Administrator Miller explained there is an additional bill for Gran Turk in the amount of \$699,900 for automated trash trucks. Also, there is 1 additional ordinance for the donation of 2 lots in the Farmington area for public purposes and resolutions certifying the review of the annual audit, cancellation of an unused grant, approval of clerical transfer to the Police Department and amendment to a coin drop event for the Kiwanis to include rain dates.

Township Committee:

Committeeman Hodson reminded the public free concerts are held Friday evenings during the summer at Canale Park. Also, a 10 year anniversary event will be held at Veterans Memorial Park on September 11th at 6:00 p.m. Committeeman Hodson referred to 3 fatal motor vehicle accidents which occurred in Egg Harbor Township over the weekend and praised our rescue personnel for their efforts.

Deputy Mayor Risley said he attended the vigil at Mainland Regional High School last night in honor of the football players killed in a motor vehicle accident over the weekend. Mr. Risley asked the motoring public to be more patient and considerate of their fellow drivers and to also be generous during our volunteer firefighters fund drives.

Committeeman Cafero asked everyone to keep the families of those who died in the recent auto accidents in their thoughts.

Mayor McCullough recognized Fire Chief Danz commending him for increasing education to our firefighters. The Mayor stated there is a potentially significant hurricane expected to hit our area this weekend and asked the public to monitor local weather conditions. The Mayor stated township personnel have been briefed and are on stand-by to deal with weather related issues.

Administrator:

Administrator Miller reported the township recently conducted its first 2 GovDeals on-line auctions. An analysis of these auctions compared to the live auctions held over the past 3 years, revealed an increase in profit as well as, a savings in staff related expenses.
